BANKING CURRENT AFFAIRS

First Bi-Monthly Monetary Policy Statement 2019-20:

- The three-day policy review meeting by the Monetary Policy Committee (MPC) headed by **RBI Governor** Shaktikanta Das in Mumbai.
- The Reserve Bank of India in its first Bi-Monthly statement 2019-20 has made the following announcements -
- The RBI reduced the policy **repo rate** under the liquidity adjustment facility (LAF) by **25 basis points** to 6.0 per cent from 6.25 per cent with immediate effect.
- The reverse repo rate under the LAF stands adjusted to **5.75** per cent.
- The marginal standing facility (MSF) rate and the Bank Rate to 6.25 per cent
- The MPC also decided to maintain the neutral monetary policy stance

RBI sells entire stake in NHB, Nabard to government for Rs 1,470 cr:

- The Reserve Bank has exited the National Housing Bank (NHB) and the National Bank for Agriculture & Rural Development (Nabard), by selling its entire stakes to government for Rs 1,450 crore and Rs 20 crore, respectively, making them fully government-owned
- The central bank has sold its stake in NHB on March 19, while it sold the stake in Nabard

RBI extends ombudsman scheme to non-deposit taking NBFCs:

- Also Provides a cost-free and expeditious complaint redressal mechanism relating to deficiency in the services by NBFCs covered under the Scheme
- All Non-Deposit Taking Non-Banking Financial Companies having customer interface, with assets **size of Rupees 100 crore** or above will come within the ambit, and shall comply with the provisions of the Ombudsman Scheme for Non- Banking Financial Companies.



RBI may have ₹3 lakh cr. excess capital : BofAML:

- As the Bimal Jalan Committee prepares to submit its report on RBI's economic capital framework, a report by Bank of America Merrill Lynch (BofAML) has said the excess reserves that the central bank holds could be up to ₹3 lakh crore or 1.5% of the GDP.
- Capping overall reserves at 20% from 25.5% will release Rs. 1.96 lakh crore.
- There's no restriction which prevents RBI from transferring the money to government

RBI issues norms for banks to set up currency chests:

- Area of the strong room/ vault of at least 1,500 sq ft. For those situated in hilly/ inaccessible places, the strong room/ vault area of at least 600 sq ft," the RBI said while specifying minimum standards for setting up new currency chests.
- the new chests should have a processing **capacity of 6.6 lakh pieces** of banknotes per day. For those situated in the hilly/inaccessible places, capacity of 2.1 lakh pieces of banknotes per day.

RBI Places NBFC-MFIs' Average Base Rate At 9.21% For Current Quarter:

• The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has communicated that the applicable average base rate to be charged by Non-Banking Financial Company - Micro Finance Institutions (NBFC-MFIs) to their borrowers for the quarter beginning April 01, 2019 will be **9.21%**

RBI first APAC central bank to begin interest rate easing cycle: Fitch:

- The Reserve Bank of India is the first central bank in the **Asia-Pacific region** to begin an explicit interest rate easing cycle buoyed by benign food inflation and easier global financial condition, Fitch Ratings
- The Monetary Policy Committee (MPC), headed by RBI Govenor Shaktikanta Das, cut rates in February and April citing prospects of benign inflation. In the four months of 2019, the RBI has cut policy interest rates twice by **0.25** per cent each to one-year low of 6 per cent.
- This is the first back-to-back rate cut since the MPC was formed in late 2016.

Fitch has a 'BBB-', the lowest investment grade, rating on India, with a stable outlook:

• Fitch estimates India to grow at **6.8** per cent in current fiscal 2019 and **7.1** per cent in 2020.

RBI Tweaks LCR Norms To Boost Liquidity:

- In a bid to further improve the cash position of banks, RBI has tweaked Liquidity Coverage Ratio (LCR) norms to provide an **additional 2% window to lenders**. As per RBI Governor Shaktikanta Das, this move will harmonise the liquidity requirements of banks and release additional money for lending.
- LCR indicates the proportion of highly liquid assets held by banks to ensure their ability to meet short-term obligations

RBI to soon release new Rs 20 bank note:

- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) announced that it will shortly issue **Rs 20 denomination** banknotes, in the Mahatma Gandhi (New) series, bearing the signature of the central bank's governor **Shaktikanta Das**. These are different in size and design compared to the notes issued earlier.
- The Rs 20 note will be **greenish-yellow** in colour. The new banknote has a motif of **Ellora Caves** on the reverse, depicting the country's cultural heritage,"

A few features of the new Rs 20 (Back)

- Motif of Ellora Caves
- Dimension of the banknote will be 63 mm x 129 mm

RBI extends deadline for legal entity identification:

- The RBI extended the deadline for Legal **Entity Identifier** (**LEI**) **codes** for participation in non-derivative markets.
- Now, the deadline for entities with net worth of over ₹1,000 crore to get the code is December 31, 2019, against the earlier deadline of April 30 this year
- This is also the deadline for those with net worth between ₹200 crore and ₹1,000 crore, while for entities with net worth of less than ₹200 crore, the deadline has been extended to March 31, 2020.

RBI to inject USD 5 bn more liquidity through 2nd dollar-rupee swap auction:



• The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) said it will inject long-term liquidity worth **USD 5 billion** into the banking system through dollar-rupee buy-sell swap for a tenure of three years on April 23, the second such auction within a month.

The RBI has signed a Statement of Commitment (SoC) to the FX Global Code.:

- The code, launched a compilation of best market practices, formulated by central banks and market participants, developed under the auspices of the **Bank for International Settlements (BIS)**, Basel.
- The RBI said the code is applicable to the wholesale **FX market** participants covering sell-side, buy-side and financial intermediaries, and is voluntary in nature.
- It does not impose any legal or regulatory obligations, and is intended to be a supplement to the local laws, rules and regulations.
- It is currently being implemented globally by the Global FX Committee (GFXC) in co-ordination with the Local FX Committee (LFXC) in each jurisdiction.

RBI sets WMA Limit for Government at Rs 75000 crore for H1 of 2019-20:

- The Reserve Bank of India, in consultation with the Government of India, has decided that the limits for
 Ways and Means Advances (WMA) for the first half of the financial year 2019-20 (April 2019 to September
 2019) will be Rs 75000 crore.
- The Reserve Bank may trigger fresh floatation of market loans when the Government of India utilises 75% of the WMA limit.

ADB committed highest-ever USD 3 bn in sovereign loans to India in 2018:

- ADB committed to provide USD 3 billion in **sovereign loans** to India in 2018, the highest level of assistance since sovereign operations began in the country in 1986, said the annual report of multilateral lending agency.
- In all, the Asian Development Bank (ADB), owned by 68 member countries, committed a total of **USD 3.88 billion**, including sovereign loans and co-financing during the year ended December 2018.

State Bank of India cuts MCLR by 5 bps, home loans cheaper by 10 bps:

- State Bank of India (SBI) reduced its MCLR by **5 bps** across all tenors and slashed interest rate on home loans **up to Rs 30 lakh** by **10** basis points.
- One-year MCLR will be 8.50% per annum (pa). The interest rates on all loans linked to MCLR stand reduced by 5 bps from April 10, 2019, India's largest lender said in statement.

SBI Launches first Green Car Loan



- State Bank of India announced the country's **first _Green Car Loan**' (Electric Vehicle) to encourage customers to buy electric vehicles. The new scheme will offer loan at 20 basis points lesser than the interest rate on the existing car loan schemes.
- The EMI perRs. 1 lakh will be lower at Rs. 1,468 for 96 months against Rs. 1,622 for 84 months, based on the maximum tenor, in line with the existing scheme.

SBI General launches cyber defence insurance for businesses:

- SBI General Insurance Monday said it has launched a product to protect businesses from financial and reputational losses due to cyber attacks.
- In the initial phase, the focus will be on SMEs and mid-market businesses, but later the product can cater to larger business conglomerates as well, the insurer said in a statement.

Exim Bank Funds Projects Worth USD 267 mn In Rwanda:

- Exim Bank has provided soft loans of **USD 266.60 million** to Rwanda for various projects.
- The funding, done in three separate tranches to Rwanda, is to support agricultural projects, development of **special economic zones (SEZs)** and for financing a road project in the African nation.

Kotak Bank Launches Debit Card-Based e-mandate On NPCI's API Platform:

- Kotak Mahindra Bank (Kotak) has launched the first debit card-based authentication solution on NPCI's (National Payments Corporation of India) e-Mandate (electronic mandate) API (Application Program Interface) platform.
- With this, it has become the first ever Destination Bank to go live with both Net Banking and Debit Card-based e-mandate authentication. The objective of this initiative is to enable Kotak customers to create electronic mandates, similar to the former e-NACH with Aadhaar + OTP via both debit card and net banking provision.

IMF & World Bank Launched 'Learning Coin' For In-House Purposes:

- The International Monetary Fund (IMF) and the World Bank have together launched a private blockchain with a pseudo-token. The new token, called "**Learning Coin**" and only accessible within the IMF and World Bank, has a purpose to teach relevant individuals within the organizations about blockchain.
- Though the coin has no real value hence the description pseudo-token staff members who pass educational milestones will receive the tokens which can then be redeemed for certain rewards.
- The purpose is to get employees to understand the applications of **blockchain technology** in the real world.

IndusInd Bank Receives NCLT Approval For Merger With Bharat Financial Inclusion:



- National Company Law Tribunal (NCLT) approved the merger of private sector lender IndusInd Bank with
 Bharat Financial Inclusion (BFIL), a microfinance company.
- Earlier, IndusInd Bank had received '**No Objection**' from Reserve Bank of India, National Stock Exchange and Bombay Stock Exchange. Bharat Financial will become a subsidiary of the private lender.

Canara Bank, Canara HSBC OBC Life launch 'Webassurance':

- Canara Bank and its life insurance partner Canara HSBC Oriental Bank of Commerce Life Insurance launched 'Webassurance' to enable its customers to purchase life insurance in a convenient and hassle-free way.
- This Life Insurance is jointly owned by Canara Bank (51%) and Oriental Bank of Commerce (23%) and HSBC Insurance Holdings (26%), the Asian insurance arm of HSBC.

Canara Bank Becomes The First Public Sector Bank In India To Meet RBI's EMV Mandate:

- ACI Worldwide, a global provider of real-time electronic payment and banking solutions, announced that
 Canara Bank has successfully rolled out major new functionality to support EMV card acquiring across its
 ATM network and Aadhaar Authentication, leveraging ACI's UP Retail Payments solution to achieve
 market firsts.
- Canara Bank, with nearly 6,300 branches and a network of more than 10,000 ATMs, is the first public sector bank to shift to EMV chip and PIN for card present transactions across the country's vast ATM network.

Vijaya Bank, Dena Bank merger with BoB to be effective from April:

• State-owned **Bank of Baroda's** proposed merger with **Dena and Vijaya Bank** will be affected from April 1. The government's amalgamation plan for these state-owned banks has already got all the necessary approvals from the regulators concerned. The Bank of Baroda board in a recent meeting also decided to issue and allot equity shares to Vijaya Bank and Dena Bank on March 11.

IDRBT Sets Up 5G Lab For Banking, Financial Sector:

- The Institute for Development and Research in Banking Technology (IDRBT), an arm of Reserve Bank of India, has launched a **5G Use Cases Lab** for banking and financial sector.
- The 5G technology, along with blockchain, will be progressively adopted by banks. Department Of Telecommunications had already launched test beds for 5G use in the academia in Hyderabad, Chennai and Bangalore to develop 5G for Indian use.

Government Raises Authorised Capital of Allahabad Bank To Rs 8,000 Crore:



- State-owned Allahabad Bank stated that the government has increased its authorised capital by Rs 5,000 crore to Rs 8,000 crore. The central government after consultation with the Reserve Bank of India increased the authorised capital of the bank.
- The increase in authorised capital will help enable the bank to raise further fund up to a maximum ceiling of Rs 8,000 crore.

Priority Sector Lending Certificates volume crosses Rs 3-trillion mark:

- The priority sector lending certificates (PSLCs) volume rocketed to Rs 3.3 trillion in FY19,up from Rs 1.9 trillion in the last financial year and **Rs 50,000 crore** in FY17.
- PSLCs relating to the small and marginal farmers segment continued to be in most demand, according to rating agency CRISIL.

Bank of India to sell 25% stake in life insurance JV SUD Life Insurance for Rs. 1,106 crore:

- Public sector lender Bank of India offered to sell a 25 per cent stake in its joint venture company Star Union
 Dai-ichi Life Insurance Co Ltd for approximately Rs. 1,106 crore(\$159.87 million).
- Star Union Dai-ichi Life Insurance Co. Ltd. (SUD Life) is a joint venture (JV) of Bank of India, Union Bank of India and Dai-ichi Life, a leading life insurance company of Japan
- Bank of India to sell 6.49 crore shares, or 25.02 per cent stake, in Star Union Dai-ichi Life Insurance Co at a floor price of 170.50 per share.

Bank of Maharashtra gets Rs 205 crore capital from govt:

- State-owned Bank of Maharashtra said that **government has infused Rs 205 crore** into the bank in lieu of preferential allotment of shares.
- The capital infusion was done on March 30, 2019.
- The issue committee of the bank in its meeting held on March 30, 2019 issued and allotted **15,47,16,981** equity shares of the bank for cash at an issue price of Rs 13.25 per share aggregating to Rs 205 crore on preferential basis to the government, Bank of Maharasthra said in a regulatory filing. ..

Bank of Baroda, Srei Equipment Finance tie up for infra equipment loans:

- Srei Equipment Finance Ltd (SEFL) and India's second largest state-run lender Bank of Baroda have entered
 in to aco-lending arrangement for infrastructure equipment. The offerings would include both business to
 business (B2B) and business to customer (B2C) propositions
- The partnership will allow Kolkata-based Srei Infrastructure Finance Ltd's equipment finance arm and Bank of Baroda to collaborate and widen their respective customer base.



• As part of the arrangement, the companies will use iQuippo, a digital marketplace for origination of loans, collection of loan dues, and auction and valuation of equipment

Karnataka Bank Signs Pact With Bharti AXA For Insurance Products:

- Karnataka Bank has entered into an MoU with Bharti AXA Life Insurance Company to distribute the latter's life insurance products. The bank will be able to provide a wide choice of life insurance products to its customers across 836 branches, supported by the products of Bharti AXA Life Insurance Company.
- This is the third such tie-up by the bank after PNB MetLife Life Insurance Company and LIC of India, both of which continue to provide insurance solutions to the customers of Karnataka Bank.

IDBI Bank Launches 'NRI-Insta-Online' Paperless Account Facility:

• IDBI Bank has launched 'NRI-Insta-Online' account opening process for NRIs residing in the Financial Action Task Force (FATF) member countries. The person will not be required to furnish physical documents as well as KYC proofs for opening an account with the bank.

Kotak Mahindra Bank Becomes First Lender To Charge For UPI Use:

- Kotak Mahindra Bank (Kotak) stated that it will **charge customers for UPI transactions** starting 1st of May 2019.
- For each Kotak Bank account, the first 30 UPI fund transfers will be free, after which a charge will be **levied** on all fund transfers from the bank account.
- This will be applicable across all platforms, including **Paytm, PhonePe, Google Pay or Truecaller Pay** among others. The bank will charge Rs 2.50 per transaction for an amount value below or equal to Rs 1,000, and Rs 5 per transaction will be levied for a payment value above Rs 1,000.

FINANCE AND ECONOMY

SEBI Reduces Minimum Subscription Requirement For REITs, InvITs:

- Markets regulator SEBI (Securities and Exchange Board of India) has reduced the minimum subscription requirement as well as defined trading lots for Real Estate Investment Trusts (REITs) and Infrastructure Investment Trusts (InvITs). SEBI has also increased the leverage limit for InvITs from 49% to 70%.
- While making an initial public offer and follow-on offer, the minimum subscription shall not be less than Rs 1 lakh for InvITs and Rs 50,000 for REITs. Currently, in the case of a REIT issue, the minimum subscription from any investor in an initial offer and follow-on public offer is not less than Rs 2 lakh, while the same is Rs 10 lakh in case of InvIT.

GST mop up hits a record ₹1.06-lakh crore in March:

- The GST collection for the month of March reached Rs 1.06 lakh crore, marking the highest ever mop-up recorded under the unified tax regime since its introduction.
- The record high came on the back of higher compliance and increase in GST returns filed.
- The total number of GSTR-3B filed till March 31 for the month of February stood at 75.95 lakh.

CRISIL Board Gives Nod For Transfer Of Ratings Business To New Subsidiary:

- CRISIL Ltd, a diversified global analytics company, will transfer its rating business to its proposed new wholly-owned subsidiary.
- The board of CRISIL gave the nod for the transfer, which is being done to comply with SEBI norms of 2018. Earlier, SEBI had modified its regulations for credit rating agencies and mandated the segregation of rating and non-ratings businesses of credit-rating agencies.
- CRISIL proposes to undertake the transfer of its ratings business through a scheme of arrangement in terms of Section 230 to 232 of the Companies Act, 2013, to be approved by the stock exchanges and the National Company Law Tribunal.

Deposits In Jan Dhan Accounts Are Set To Cross Rs 1 Lakh Crore Mark:

- The total deposits in Jan Dhan Account are set to cross Rs 1 lakh crore soon. The scheme was launched on 28th August 2014 by the Modi-government with an aim to provide universal access to banking facilities to all households
- On 3rd April, the total balance in the Jan Dhan accounts was at Rs 97,665.66 and the total number of Jan Dhan accounts crossed 35.39 crores. Also, more than 27.89 crores account holders have been issued the Rupay debit cards.

Reliance Jio acquires chatbot making startup Haptik for Rs. 700 crore

- Reliance Industries (RIL) subsidiary Reliance Jio Digital has acquired a majority stake in Mumbai based Artificial Intelligence-based conversational platform Haptik for Rs. 700 crore.
- In the Rs. 700-crore deal, Rs. 230 crore will go for business transfer and Rs. 470 crore will go towards expansion.
- Reliance will hold about 87% of Haptik while the company's founders and employees will own the rest of the shares through stock option grants.
- All of Haptik's business and holdings will be transferred to Reliance Jio Digital Services.

Eight core industries show 2.1% growth in February 2019:



- The combined index of eight core industries stood at 125.8 in February 2019, which indicates a marginal increase of 2.1 per cent during the month.
- The eight core industries, including coal, crude oil, natural gas, refinery products, fertilisers, steel, cement and electricity, are responsible for almost 41 per cent of the weight of items included in the Index of Industrial Production (IIP).
- The dismal show in February was on account of fall in output registered in the crude oil and refinery products.
- Coal production: It grew by 7.3% in February 2019 against 1.3% growth in the same period a year ago.
- Steel production: It recorded 17.92% growth as against 5% growth in the same period a year ago.
- Natural gas production: It grew by 3.8%.
- Fertilizers Sector: It grew by 2.5%.
- Cement production: It grew by 8%.
- Electricity production: It grew by 0.7%, falling from 4.6% growth in February 2018.
- Production of crude oil: It recorded -6.1% growth.
- Refinery products: It recorded -0.8% growth

Bandhan Bank Gets CCI Nod For Merger With Gruh Finance:

- Bandhan Bank has received approval from the Competition Commission of India (CCI) for the proposed scheme of amalgamation of Gruh Finance with the bank. The approval has been made under sub-section (1) of Section 31 of the Competition Act, 2002.
- Bandhan Bank had, in January 2019, announced the merger of Gruh Finance with it. The move was taken to bring down promoter holding in the bank to 61% from 82.3%.

Sebi fixes minimum net worth for clearing corporations at IFSC:

- The Securities and Exchange Board of India (Sebi) has prescribed that all recognised clearing corporations in International Financial Services Centre (IFSC), need to maintain Rs 50 crore net worth in the form of liquid assets on commencement of operations.
- Also, every such clearing corporation will raise over a period of three years from commencement of
 operations, its net worth, to be maintained in the form of liquid assets, to a minimum of Rs 100 crore or
 capital as determined in accordance with the aforementioned Sebi circular.

Paytm Money Receives SEBI Approval To Start Stock Broking Services:

• The Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) has given approval to Paytm Money the investment and wealth management platform of the mobile payments company to start offering broking services.



• It had applied for the licence in October 2018. Paytm Money has also received membership of NSE and BSE.

BuyUcoin Introduces First Indian Platform for Wholesale Cryptocurrency Trading:

- BuyUcoin, second oldest Cryptocurrency Exchange in India, has introduced a new and unique platform for wholesale cryptocurrency trading.
- This platform works on 'free trading model' which means it charges zero fee on any trade. It is also known as
 OTC (Over-the-counter) Desk that allows users to trade on a large scale with low price fluctuations.

ETMONEY Becomes India's First Comprehensive Financial Services App to Integrate with UPI:

- ETMONEY India's largest app for financial services has integrated with Unified Payment Interface (UPI) as a payment method. The reason for this is to double its monthly user base by the end of 2019.
- This integration will simplify the mutual fund payment for millions of ETMONEY users. ETMONEY is owned by Times Internet which is a part of the Times Group.

Sebi extends phase 1 deadline of UPI for retail IPO investors till June 30:

- Markets regulator Sebi Wednesday extended the timeline for the implementation of phase 1 of Unified Payments Interface (UPI) as an alternative payment mechanism for retail investors buying shares in a public issue.
- To ensure smooth transition to UPI in ASBA (Application Supported by Block Amount) and in the back drop
 of the representation received from various stakeholders, Sebi said, "it has been decided to extend the timeline
 for implementation of Phase I... by 3 months i.e. till June 30, 2019"

IMF cuts India GDP growth forecast to 7.3% for 2019-20:

- The International Monetary Fund (IMF) cut India's GDP growth forecast for 2019-20, following similar action by the Asian Development Bank (ADB) and the Reserve Bank of India (RBI).
- In India, growth is projected to pick up to 7.3% in 2019 (2019-20) and 7.5% in 2020 IMF said in its World Economic Outlook report.
- Both ADB and RBI last week cut their 2019-20 growth projection for India to 7.2% from 7.4% earlier.
- The Central Statistics Office (CSO) to trim its 2018-19 forecast to 7% in February from 7.2% estimated in the previous month.

HDFC Bank and Max Bupa launch AnyTimeHealth machines to distribute health insurance products

- HDFC Bank and Max Bupa (insurance company) have launched a 'AnyTimeHealth (ATH)' machines.
- ATH machine is completely automated, technology-based model which allows customers to avail health assessment and buy a policy instantly, without any manual intervention.



• In the phase-1, 15-20 ATH machines will be installed at HDFC Bank branches across multiple cities.

Lakshmi Vilas Bank To Merge With Indiabulls Housing Finance:

- The board of Lakshmi Vilas Bank (LVB) approved the merger of the private sector lender with Indiabulls Housing Finance (IBH) through a share swap deal. The merger will help Indiabulls get access to low-cost stable funds and entry into banking.
- The merger will also enable Tamil Nadu-based LVB to obtain a larger geographical presence. The merged entity will have a net worth Rs19,472 crore and a loan book Rs1,23,393 crore for the nine months of FY19. IBH's board has constituted a reorganisation committee headed by independent director and former RBI Deputy Governor SS Mundra.

BSNL gets license for in-flight connectivity

- Bharat Sanchar Nigam Limited (BSNL) has received the In-Flight Connectivity license from the Department
 of Telecommunications (DoT) for enabling in-flight and maritime connectivity (IFMC) within Indian
 airspace.
- BSNL and Inmarsat, which is the satellite partner of BSNL, also operates the GX Aviation service will be able to offer in-flight connectivity to airlines. With this facility users can send messages, surf the internet and/or tweet, when a flight is at a minimum height of 3,000m in Indian airspace.
- Presently any form of internet connectivity for both domestic and international flights is not available on Indian flights. After, this facility enabled, users will still have restricted amounts of data available for their uses, applicable for all airlines.

Microsoft Becomes World's Third Company To Be Worth \$1 Trillion:

- Microsoft has reached a valuation of one trillion dollars for the first time after posting an increase in profits. It
 makes the software giant only the third publicly-traded company in history to reach the threshold after Apple
 and Amazon passed it in 2018.
- Microsoft's current valuation also means that it has again taken over Apple as the world's most valuable company.

Infosys arm to buy 75% stake in Dutch bank subsidiary:

Global software major Infosys stated that its consulting arm would buy 75 per cent equity stake in Starter N.V., a subsidiary of the Dutch-based ANN AMRO Bank for Rs. 999 crore (\$144 million) for strategic partnership in The Netherlands.

WTO trims global trade growth forecast for 2019 to 2.6% from 3.7%:



- Global trade growth is expected to be lower in 2019 than it was last year, the World Trade Organization forecast on Tuesday. This could have a major impact on the outbound shipment from India.
- The WTO revised growth to 2.6 per cent from its earlier estimates of 3.7 per cent. This is lower than the 3 per cent growth recorded in 2018. It attributed its dismal outlook to widespread "tensions" and economic uncertainty.

PayU acquires digital financial security firm Wibmo for USD 70 mn:

- Digital payments facilitator PayU has acquired US-based financial technology firm Wibmo for USD 70 million (about Rs. 484 crore), that will help the company scale-up its business. Under the agreement, PayU and Wibmo businesses will continue to run separately.
- Wibmo, a digital payment security and mobile payment technologies firm, will continue to operate and serve all of its clients as a wholly-owned subsidiary of PayU.

ADB cuts India's growth rate to 7.2% in 2019-20:

• Asian Development Bank (ADB) on Wednesday lowered India's growth by 40 basis points to 7.2 per cent in fiscal year 2019-20. Still. It will be fastest growing economy in the world. The growth rate in FY 2020-21 likely to be 7.3 per cent.

Govt manages to meet revised fiscal deficit target of 3.4% of GDP:

- The government has managed to meet the revised fiscal deficit target of 3.4 per cent of the GDP after it cut last minute expenditure and rolled over fuel subsidies to make up for the shortfall in tax collection.
- The interim Budget presented in February revised upward the fiscal deficit target to 3.4 per cent from 3.3 per cent of GDP estimated earlier for 2018-19.

World Bank Projects India"s GDP to Expand 7.5% in FY20:

- India's GDP growth is expected to accelerate moderately to 7.5 percent in fiscal year 2019-20.
- The Economy driven by continued investment strengthening, particularly private-improved export performance andresilient consumption.
- The real GDP growth is estimated at 7.2 percent in financial year 2018-19, Meanwhile, agriculture growth was robust at 4 per cent

IMF Cuts India's GDP Growth Forecast To 7.3% For FY20:

- The International Monetary Fund (IMF) cut its economic growth forecasts for India by 20 basis points (bps) each from its January predictions to 7.3% for FY20 and 7.5% for the next fiscal.
- Citing persistent risks from the trade war, it lowered 2019 global growth forecast by 20 basis points to 3.3%, the weakest since 2009 when the subprime crisis had flared up

Government Retains Interest Rate For General Provident Fund at 8%:

- The government has retained the interest rate for General Provident Fund (GPF), Contributory Provident Fund and other related schemes at 8 per cent for the first quarter of the current financial year.
- The interest rate on these funds was at 8% in January-March quarter of 2018-19 and government kept it unchanged for April to June for 2019-20. The interest rate will be applicable on provident funds of central government employees, railways and defence forces.

HDFC AMC ranked 1st in terms of Assets:

- India's asset management companies (AMCs) own assets under management (AUM) worth Rs24.46 trillion, according to data released by the Association of Mutual Funds in India (Amfi).
- HDFC Asset Management Co. Ltd has claimed the top spot with an average AUM of Rs3.42 trillion, overtaking ICICI Prudential Asset Management Co. Ltd with an average AUM of at Rs3.20 trillion.
- Out of the total industry assets, a huge 82.7% is owned by the top 10 AMCs, who have owned around 80% of the industry assets over at least three years now.

- Over 3,100 special kits for collecting blood and semen samples, besides other evidence, to carry out

 by the Ministry of Home Affairs, officials said Sunday.
- The Sexual Assault Evidence Collection Kits (SAECK) or 'rape investigation kits' are designed to carry out immediate medico-legal investigation and aid in furnishing evidence in sexual assault and rape cases.

Around 5000 Konyak women dance to set a Guinness World Record at Mon, Nagaland:

- The programme organized at Mon (Nagaland) during the Aoleang Monyu festival (usually held between 1st April to 3rd April every year) around 5000 Konyak Naga women in their traditional attire attempted to set a Guinness World Record for the 'Largest Traditional Konyak Dance'.
- The festival is celebrated for the arrival of Spring and for a good upcoming harvest.
- The theme of the Aoleang Monyu festival aka Mini Hornbill festival was 'Empowering women for cultural heritage'.
- Konyak Union in coordination with other organisations of the tribe, namely, Konyak Nyupuh Sheko Khong (KNSK) and Konyak Students' Union (KSU) organized the event. The objective of the event was to preserve the cultural heritage of the region and the people and to promote tourism.

India and the Netherlands agreed to improve the bilateral cooperation in various fields:

• India was agreed to improve the bilateral cooperation with the Netherlands in various fields, including political, economic scientific and cultural cooperation during the Foreign Office Consultations in New Delhi.

20 states join pan-India single emergency helpline number '112':

- Twenty states and Union territories have so far joined a pan-India network of single emergency helpline number '112' on which immediate assistance can be sought by anyone in distress.
- The '112' helpline is an integration of police (100), fire (101) and women (1090) helpline numbers and the project is being implemented under the central government's Nirbhaya Fund.
- The single number for emergency services is similar to '911' in the United States.

Terror funding, drug trade, fake currencies forced India to suspend LoC trade with Pak:



- Infiltration of third-party goods, channeling funds and arms for terrorists, clandestine trade of drugs and pumping fake currencies were among some compelling reasons, which left India with no other option but to suspend the Line of Control (LoC) trade with Pakistan, said sources in Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA).
- "LoC trade across Chakkan-Da-Bagh and Salamabad was intended to be a confidence-building measure for
 the population living in remote areas of Jammu and Kashmir and living across LoC in PoJK and J-K.
 However, third parties manipulated the trade and misused the facility for trading goods being produced from
 outside Jammu and Kashmir," said sources.

- South Korea launches the world's first fully-fledged 5G mobile networks Friday, a transformational leap that already has superpowers sparring for control of an innovation that could potentially change the day-to-day lives of billions of people.
- The superfast communications heralded by fifth-generation wireless technology will ultimately underpin everything from toasters to telephones; from electric cars to power grids.

UK accepts EU's offer to extend Brexit deadline to Oct 31:

- The decision was taken at an emergency meeting in Brussels where the EU leaders agreed to offer British Prime Minister Theresa May a six-month extension. In March, British Prime Minister Theresa May had requested the European Union to grant the United Kingdom a short term extension till June 30 to prevent the U.K. leaving the bloc without a deal, because the British Parliament has repeatedly failed to decide on the terms of the exit.
- If United Kingdom stays beyond May 22, it will have to take part in European Parliament elections in May 2019 or else leave the bloc on June 1 without deal. If the extension had not been agreed to, Britain would have left the block without a deal on April 12.

Tummy timetables: WHO has lifestyle advice for kids:

- The United Nations on Wednesday released its first-ever recommendations on physical activity for children under five, with disputed advice on subjects ranging from screen time to "tummy time".
- The guidelines from the World Health Organization may read to some parents like common-sense practices, including not exposing babies under one-year-old to screens.

Hong Kong's stock market overtakes Japan to be world's third largest:

- The city's equity market has overtaken Japan to be the world's third largest in value, behind only the U.S. and mainland China, courtesy of a rebound in Hong Kong stocks after their worst year since 2011.
- Hong Kong's market cap was \$5.78 trillion as of Tuesday, compared with \$5.76 trillion for Japan, according
 to data compiled by Bloomberg based on where primary securities are listed.



- The Asian city's Hang Seng Index climbed 17 per cent this year through Tuesday, when it closed at its highest since June 15.
- Internet giant Tencent Holdings Ltd. has been the main driver with a 22 per cent gain. Japan's Topix Index advanced 8.3 percent in that period.

Over 113 mn people across 53 countries experienced acute hunger last year:

- More than 113 million people across 53 countries experienced acute hunger last year, with conflict, climaterelated disasters and economic turbulence mainly driving the food insecurity crisis, according to a new joint UN and European Union (EU) report.
- The Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO), World Food Programme (WFP) and EU Global Report on Food Crises 2019', shows that the number going chronically-hungry has remained well over 100 million over the past three years, with the number of countries affected, rising.

Google opens first Africa Artificial Intelligence lab in Ghana:

- Tech giant Google is all set to exhibit itself as AI first company in front of the world by opening new research centers across the globe such as in Tokyo, Zurich, New York, and Paris. Following this idea, the company has opened its first center in Africa in Ghana capital city, Accra.
- Using Google's AI machine app 'TensorFlow', farmers analyze the issue with their plants and boost their production. TensorFlow was outsourced by the company to help developers generate solutions to real-world problems.

Karan Johar's wax statue unveiled at Madam Tussauds Singapore:

- Karan Johar, one of the most prominent personalities in Bollywood industry, has become India's first film-maker to have a wax statue at Madame Tussauds in Singapore.

London becomes first city to implement 24x7 pollution charge zone:

- London on Monday (local time) became the first city in the world to implement a special Ultra Low Emission Zone (ULEZ) that would charge an entry fee for older vehicles if they do not meet the emission standards.
- In an attempt to reduce air pollution and protect public health, the ULEZ will be operational for 24 hours and seven days a week, according to a statement by London mayor Sadiq Khan's office.

UAE adopts new national AI strategy aimed at becoming global leader:

- The UAE's Cabinet has adopted a new 'National Artificial Intelligence Strategy 2031' aimed at positioning the UAE as a global leader in AI. The strategy will also seek to develop an —integrated system that employs artificial intelligence in vital areas in the UAE.
- The strategy includes eight objectives, including establishing an incubator for AI innovations, the employment of AI in customer service, attracting and training AI talent and research capabilities and providing a data-driven infrastructure to support AI experiments.

Etihad becomes 1st major airline to operate plastic-free flight:

- The UAE's flag carrier Etihad Airways has become the first airline in the Gulf region to operate a flight without any single-use plastics on board, in a bid to raise awareness about pollution on Earth Day.
- According to the Abu Dhabi-based national airline of the UAE, the flight EY484 landed in Brisbane on April 22, Earth Day.

Singapore"s Changi Airport touts the world"s tallest indoor waterfall.

- Singapore's Changi Airport has long been touted as the —best airport in the world, when it will officially open a dazzling presecurity attraction known as Jewel. The Jewel Changi Airport is about \$1.3 billion dollar project, connecting three of the four terminals at Changi Airport with the aim to increase the number of passengers coming to Singapore for visits and stopovers.
- Inside is a lush four-story tiered garden, more than 280 retail and dining outlets, a hotel, a multi-screen IMAX theater and its centerpiece: a 130-foot-tall Rain Vortex, which is the world's tallest indoor waterfall.

Emirates Islamic became world's first Islamic bank to launch banking via WhatsApp:

- Dubai based Emirates Islamic has announced the launch of Chat Banking services for customers via WhatsApp, marking a global first in the Islamic banking sector.
- The Chat Banking solution allows customers to use features such as checking account balances and temporarily blocking or unblocking of an existing card.
- All messages on Emirates Islamic's verified WhatsApp Business account are encrypted, ensuring confidentiality and security.

Israeli PM intends to name Golan Heights settlement after Donald Trump

Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu intends to name a new settlement in the Golden heights after US
 President Donald Trump. This decision has been taken as an expression of gratitude towards Mr Trump for his historic decision to recognise Israel's sovereignty over the Golan Heights.



• Israel captured the Golan from Syria in a 1967 war and annexed the territory in 1981, however, the move was not recognized internationally, until Trump signed a decree recognizing Israeli sovereignty over the strategic plateau.

Japan reveals new 'era' name ahead of emperor's abdication:

- Japan on Monday announced its new imperial era, which will begin next month after Emperor Akihito abdicates, will be known as "Reiwa", a word that includes the character for "harmony".
- The name consists of two characters: "Rei", which can have meanings related to "order" but also "auspicious" and "Wa", usually translated as "peace" or "harmony".

Foundation stone laying ceremony of 1st Hindu temple in UAE

- The Foundation Stone Laying Ceremony (Shilanyas Vidhi) of the first traditional Hindu Mandir in Abu Dhabi.
- Mahant Swami Maharaj, the sixth spiritual successor of Bhagwan Swaminarayan and the spiritual head of BAPS Swaminarayan Sanstha, will also preside over the foundation stone laying ceremony of the BAPS Hindu Mandir in Abu Dhabi.
- The first traditional temple in Abu Dhabi will act as a catalyst for the flourishment of humanitarian values and harmony between the two countries. The temple will become a medium to represent India's identity.

In a first, Google drone will start deliveries of takeaways in Australia:

- A Google-linked firm will start delivering takeaways and other small items to Canberra residents after the company received approval from aviation watchdogs in Australia.
- Drone Company "Wing" -- an offshoot of Google's parent company Alphabet -- has been trialling deliveries for the last 18 months, but will now be able to go ahead full time.

Saudi government raises India's Haj quota to 2 lakh:

- Saudi Arabia has issued a formal order increasing the Haj quota of India to two lakhs from one lakh seventy
 five-thousand. In February this year, the Saudi Crown Prince Mohammed bin Salman at a meeting with Prime
 Minister Narendra Modi had announced that Indian Haj quota would be increased by 25 thousand to two
 lakhs. This is the third hike in three consecutive years.
- As many as 2,340 Indian Muslim women will go for the pilgrimage without male companion or Mehram. This is the third hike in three consecutive years. In 2017, the quota was increased by 35,000 while last year, it was raised by 5,000 to take the number to 1,75,000

UK introduces world"s first online safety regulations:



- The UK government has introduced the world's first framework designed to hold internet companies accountable for the safety of those using their services, as well to tackle potential harm to users.
- Under the Online Harms whitepaper, which is a joint proposal from the Department for Digital, Culture,
 Media and Sport (DCMS) and the Home Office, social media and technology companies will need to take
 reasonable steps to protect their customers from threats stemming from their offerings.

World's first malaria vaccine launched in Africa:

- The world's first malaria vaccine has been launched in Malawi after concerted efforts of over 30 years to protect children from the deadly disease that claims over 435,000 lives globally every year.
- The World Health Organization (WHO) welcomed the Government of Malawi's landmark pilot programme.

Russia's floating nuclear power plant ready for operations:

- Russia's Rosatom State Atomic Energy Corporation (Rosatom) on Monday said its floating nuclear power unit is ready for commercial operations.
- In a statement, Rosatom said the two reactors of the floating power unit (FPU) were successfully brought up to 100 per cent capacity on March 31, and these confirmed operational stability of its main and auxiliary equipment, as well as the automatic process control systems.

India builds maternity hospital in Nepal's Siraha:

- The Chandra Narayan Yadav Memorial Maternity Hospital, made on an Indian grant of Nepalese Rupees 26.90 million, was inaugurated by Ambassador of India to Nepal, Manjeev Singh Puri.
- The 25-bedded maternity hospital is built to provide access to maternity and health care services to the people
 of 50 village development committees (VDC) in and around the district of Siraha.

Beijing Hosts Second Belt and Road Forum:

• The second edition of Belt and Road Forum (BRF) was held in Beijing, China from April 25th to April 27th, 2019 in which 37 heads-of-state and 159 countries had participated along with United Nations Secretary-General AntonioGuterres and International Monetary Chief (IMF) Christine Lagarde. The theme of this event was "Belt and Road Cooperation: Shaping a Brighter Shared Future".

Indonesia releases Ramayana stamp:

- Indonesia on Tuesday released a special commemorative stamp on the theme of Ramayana to mark the 70th anniversary of diplomatic ties with India.
- The stamp, designed by renowned Indonesian sculptor Padmashri Bapak Nyoman Nuart, features a scene from Hindu epic Ramayana in which Jatayu valiantly fought to save Sita.

- The quality of air in Varanasi, Prime Minister Modi's 2014 Lok Sabha constituency, is positioned 3rd on the WHO's (World Health Organisation) list of 15 most polluted cities in the world, by the _Political Leaders Position and Action on Air Quality in India 2014-2019' report, released by Climate Trends. Kanpur (in Uttar Pradesh) is the most polluted city in the world and is positioned 1 on the list.
- 14 of the 15 most polluted cities in the world (mentioned by World Health Organisation (WHO) are in India. Out of them, 4 are in Uttar Pradesh. WHO's report states that Varanasi in Uttar Pradesh is witnessing a rise in the number of people sufferingfrom allergies and respiratory problems due to huge amount of construction in the city. Faridabad in Haryana is in 2nd position after Kanpur.

Over 1.2 M early deaths in India due to air pollution: a report released by State of Global Air-2019:

• On 3rd April 2019, as per the State of Global Air 2019 report, over 1.2 million people died in India due to air pollution in 2017.

Time's 100 most influential people:

• 3 Indians have placed in the list: Mukesh Ambani, Arundhati Katju, Menaka Guruswamy.

Jharkhan's Dhanbad tops 4G availability list in India:

According to report _OpenSignal's Hottest city for 4G Availability' released by OpenSignal, Dhanbad, which
is also known as the coal capital of India has the highest 4G availability of 95.3%, followed by Ranchi which
has 95% of 4G Availability. The report revealed 4G Availability across the top 50 Indian cities



Both Ranchi and Dhanbad are two cities in Jharkhand and they are the only two cities to have over 95% of 4G coverage. Srinagar is one of the remote areas in the country stood third on the list with 4G Availability score of 94.9%.

According to SIPRI report, India's military expenditure rises by 3.1% to reach \$66.5 billion and Pakistan's by 11% to reach \$11.4 billion in 2018:

• According to the report from the Stockholm International Peace Research Institute (SIPRI), a think-tank, the world's military expenditure has risen by 2.6% to reach 1.82 \$ trillion in 2018. - ISO stands for —International Organisation for Standardisation|| that is responsible for establishing the standard in different areas of activities.

113 mn people of 53 countries faced severe hunger in 2018, as per Global Report on Food Crises 2019:

• In accordance with the annual 2019 Global Report on Food Crises, around 113 million people across 53 countries faced severe huger in 2018. In comparison to the figures of 2017, the number is reduced from 124 million but it requires urgent humanitarian assistance.

HDFC Bank ranked No. 1 in India by Forbes:

- HDFC Bank has been at the forefront in leveraging technology to give its 43 million customers a superior banking experience.  open platform to promote participation, skilling and empowerment among young children across different
 communities.
- Through this collaboration, AIM and UNICEF seek to promote participation, skilling and empowerment of
 adolescent girls and boys in and out-of-school, via Atal Innovation Mission's programs. This strategic
 partnership will also help effectively build capacities of adolescents, young entrepreneurs, mentors and
 teachers.

For setting up India-Africa Institute of Agriculture and Rural Development (IAIARD) in Malawi, India signed an agreement with a development bank:

India has signed an agreement with National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development Consultancy
 Service (NABCONS) for setting up India-Africa Institute of Agriculture and Rural Development (IAIARD) in
 Malawi to enhance capacity in the areas of agro-financing and entrepreneurship development for African
 countries.

Indian Army signs MoU with NHPC for construction of tunnels on China, Pakistan borders:



- Indian Army signed an MoU with National Hydroelectric Power Corporation Limited (NHPC) on Thursday to construct tunnels on borders with China and Pakistan for storage of ammunition and other war-related equipment.
- Under the pilot project, three tunnels will be built on China border while one will be built along the Line of Control with Pakistan.
- The project is meant to bolster the Indian Army's capabilities along the Chinese border where India's infrastructural development is far outpaced by that of China.

Cabinet approves MoU between India and Cambodia in the field of Communications:

The Union Cabinet chaired by Prime Minister Narendra Modi has given ex post-facto approval to the MoU
between India and Cambodia on collaboration in the field of Communications. The main motive behind this
pact is to strengthen bilateral cooperation and mutual understanding between India and Cambodia in the field
of communications.

Tata Power, Indraprastha Gas ink pact for rooftop solar projects:

- Tata Power has signed a pact with Indraprastha Gas Limited (IGL) for setting up rooftop solar projects in the country. Tata Power is India's largest integrated power utility; IGL is country's largest CNG distribution company.
- The pact signed between Tata Power and IGL is for green energy solutions including rooftop solar projects, various integrated services including setting up of commercial scale EV charging/battery swapping stations

India offers USD 100 million credit to Bolivia for development projects:

- Under the framework of South-South Cooperation, India has offered \$100 million Line of Credit to Bolivia
 for financing development projects. Accompanied by a 100-member strong official delegation, President
 Ramnath Kovind had wide ranging discussions with his counterpart President Evo Morles of Bolivia.
- The discussions focussed on political, economic and cultural issues including space, mining, IT, pharmaceutical and traditional medicines.

Cabinet apprised about MoU between India and Brazil in the area of Biotechnology

 Union Cabinet chaired by Prime Minister Narendra Modi gave its approval for an MoU signed in May, 2018 between India and Brazil. - With this, RNAM becomes the first company in India, to provide conversational interface that would help
 customers regarding funds transactions. In the first phase, the functionality would be launched in Reliance
 Simply Save app for the customers. RNAM is a joint venture between Anil Ambani-led Reliance Capital and
 Japan's Nippon Life Insurance Co Ltd.

Cabinet approves pact between India and Denmark in the field of Renewable energy:

Union cabinet chaired by Prime Minister Narendra Modi gave its approval for an agreement between Ministry
of New and Renewable Energy and Denmark's Ministry for Energy, Utilities and Climate to facilitate
deliberate collaboration in renewable energy with focus on offshore wind energy and a Letter of Intent to
establish an Indo-Danish Centre of Excellence for renewable energy in India.

ICC to join hands with Interpol to tackle corruption in sport:

• The International Cricket Council (ICC) has sought closer working relations with the Interpol to widen the scope of its fight against corruption in the sport. The idea is to ensure that players are better educated about the corruptors and Interpol's vast network would be helpful in this.

NIIF, ROADIS to create a platform to invest \$2 billion in road projects

- National Investment and Infrastructure Fund (NIIF) and PSP Investment owned ROADIS will together create aplatform to invest \$2 billion in road projects.
- The platform will invest up to \$ 2 billion of equity to target Toll Operate Transfer (TOT) models, acquisitions of existing road concessions and investment opportunities in the road sector with the aim of creating a large roads platform in the country.

- The 31-year-old, Australia's Claire Polosak became the first womanumpire to stand in a men's ODI in the final match of ICC World Cricket League 2.
- Previously, she stood in 15 women's ODI matches, the first one played between Australia and South Africa in November 2016.



Ajinkya Rahane becomes 1st Indian cricketer to join Hampshire Indian cricketer:

 Ajinkya Madhukar Rahane became the first overseas player from India to represent Hampshire and he will replace Aiden Kyle Markram, who will join South Africa's World Cup Team.

Sathiyan becomes first Indian to break into top-25 of ITTF rankings:

- India's G Sathiyan on Monday scaled new heights in his rapidly rising career by becoming the first Indian to break into the top-25 of world rankings.
- Sathiyan rose four spots to be 24th in the latest ITTF rankings, following his impressive sixth place finish in the Asia Cup in Yokohama earlier this month. Last week, he was the sole Indian to reach the round of 32 in the World Championships in Hungary.

Papua New Guinea got ODI status after USA and Oman:

- Papua New Guinea, a south-western pacific country got their One Day International (ODI) status and a place in International Cricket Council (ICC) Cricket World Cup League 2 after beating Oman by 145-run.
- Now, Papua New Guinea joins Namibia, Oman, Scotland, the US, Nepal and UAE in the ICC Cricket World Cup League 2. In the next two-and-a-half-year all six team will play 36 ODIs each in the run-up to the Men's Cricket World Cup 2023.

Manu Bhaker & Saurabh Chaudhary win India's second gold at ISSF World Cup:

- Manu Bhaker and Saurabh Chaudhary won their 2nd World Cup gold in the 10m Air Pistol Mixed Team
- The Indian duo outclassed Jiang Ranxin and Pang Wei of China 16-6
- Anjum Moudgil and Divyansh Singh won India its first gold at the ISSF World Cup in Beijing.

Asian Wrestling Championship 2019 Concludes: India Finishes With 16 Medals, Iran Tops:

India wrapped up their campaign at the Asian Wrestling Championships on a resounding note with 16 medals after Harpreet Singh settled for a silver in 82kg on the final day of competitions. Only Bajrang Punia won the gold medal after defeating Kazakhstan's Sayatbek Okassov by 12-7 in 65kg men's freestyle. Asian Wrestling Championship 2019 was held at Xi'an, China.

- It was the second win for Dani opposite Christophersen.
- The 22-year-old won the Ghana international crown in 2018 second Karvy All India junior-ranking badminton tournament in 2012.

Lewis Hamilton Wins Bahrain Grand Prix 2019:

- Five times world champion Lewis Hamilton won Bahrain Grand Prix 2019 title by beating Valtteri Bottas of Finland who secured the second position.
- Charles Leclerc was finished at the third position and became Ferrari's youngest ever race winner at the age of 21.

Lewis Hamilton clinched Formula One's 1000th race title British racing driver:

- Indian shooters continued their dominance claiming five gold medals on the final day of the Asian Airgun Championships to sign off with a total of 25 medals in Taoyuan, Taipei.

Golfer Tiger Woods won fifth green jacket and 15th major title:

- Golfer Tiger Woods won fifth Masters and 15th major title at Augusta National Golf Club.
- It was the 43-year-old American golfer's first major title victory in 11 years and his first Master's win since 2005.
- All-time leader, Jack Nicklaus is just three major titles ahead of the former world No.1.

Indian Squash player Saurav Ghosal became the first Indian to move in top 10 Squash world ranking:

- On 1st April 2019, Saurav Ghosal moved up two places to become the first Indian male squash player to break into the top 10 of the latest PSA (Professional Squash Association) world ranking.

DEFENCE

India-Australia bilateral defence exercise will deepen strategic ties:

- India and Australia would further deepen defence and strategic relationship with the third iteration of bilateral exercise AUSINDEX 19, which will see the largest Australian defence joint task force to visit India.
- The Australian High Commission, in a statement, said that Australia and India's cooperation on shared maritime security interests in the Indian Ocean is set to rise to a new level with the biennial, bilateral exercise.

Indian Navy warships to take part in Chinese fleet review:



- Two Indian Navy warships, namely the destroyer INS Kolkata and tanker INS Shakti, would be taking part in Chinese international fleet review to be held at Qingdao.
- The celebrations are being held by the Chinese as part of the 70th Anniversary of the People's Liberation Army's Navy there and major navies are likely to take part in it.
- Indian Navy Ships Kolkata and Shakti are scheduled to arrive Qingdao, China on 21 Apr 19 to participate in the International Fleet Review as part of 70th Anniversary celebrations of PLA (Navy)

India successfully test fires sub-sonic cruise missile 'Nirbhay':

- India today successfully test-fired its first indigenously designed and developed long range sub-sonic cruise missile 'Nirbhay', which has 1,000 km operational range and a capacity to carry warheads of up to 300 kg.
- It was successfully test fired from the Integrated Test Range (ITR) at Chandipur along the Odisha coast.

Pak navy successfully test-fires indigenous cruise missile:

An indigenously developed cruise missile successfully test fired by Pakistan Navy from its latest Azmat-class
Patrol Craft, PNS Himmat (1027) in North Arabian Sea. The cruise missile has capability of anti-ship missile
and land attack. The media arm of the Pakistan Armed Forces, Inter Services Public Relations (ISPR) has not
revealed the missile type which Pakistan Navy has tested.

2nd Edition of Indian Navy-Vietnam Peoples' Navy Bilateral Exercise (In – VPN Bilat Ex) Concludes:

- The exercise was undertaken as a part of the ongoing Overseas Deployment of Eastern Fleet ships to South East Asian countries. IN Ships Kolkata under the command of Capt Aditya Hara and Shakti under the command of Capt Sriram Amur participated in the exercise, comprising a harbour and a sea phase.
- The Navy to Navy cooperation involves a Composite Training Programme in the fields of Submarine, Aviation and Dockyard training. The two countries have also signed an agreement to exchange White Shipping Information and have a running 'Information Sharing' programme.

Indian Army patrol team discovers wreckage of WW II vintage US Air Force aircraft:

- A 12-member patrol team of the Indian Army along with a police official has discovered the wreckage of a World War II vintage US Air Force aircraft in Roing district of Arunachal Pradesh.
- The wreckage was located in a remote location at a distance of 30km from Roing and was covered by thick
 undergrowth and buried under five feet of snow. The discovery of this aircraft and other warlike stores will
 lead to the revelation of some historical inputs. World War II was fought from 1939 to 1945.



Indian, US Navies hold anti-submarine warfare exercise:

- Indian and the US Navies have held a joint submarine-hunting exercise in the Indian Ocean, aiming to lay the groundwork for coordinating maritime patrol and reconnaissance.
- Indian and the US' P-8 anti-submarine aircraft, along with the USS Spruance, a guided-missile destroyer, participated in the anti-submarine warfare training.
- The Indian P-8I Neptune aircraft from the Naval Air Squadron 312 based at Naval Station Rajali in Arakkonam, Tamil Nadu, joined the US P-8A Poseidon aircraft from Patrol Squadron VP-8 "Fighting Tigers", based in Jacksonville, Florida, in the exercise.

Army to hold joint exercise with coast guard, says Rawat:

- Indian army chief General Bipin Rawat Monday said the army is planning tocarry out a joint training and exercise with the Indian Coast Guard.
- He said the coast guard and the Indian Navy maintain coastal security and maritime surveillance.
- After commissioning the coast guard's offshore patrol vessel (OPV) Veera, the third in the series of the newgeneration OPV here, he said Veera would help the coast guard monitor maritime boundaries more effectively.

Navy reviews outcome of Sea Vigil exercise:

- The Indian Navy and several other agencies involved in coastal defence and maritime security brainstormed over the outcome of the 'Sea Vigil' exercise -- the first-of-its-kind multi-agency drill covering the entire 7,516 km-long Indian coastline and exclusive economic zone.
- The mega exercise took place on January 22 and 23 with participation of 13 coastal states and union territories along with all maritime stakeholders with an aim to check the efficacy of maritime security and surveillance.

Modi govt approves new agency to develop space warfare weapon systems:

- With the aim of enhancing the capabilities of the armed forces to fight wars in space, the government has
 approved the setting up of a new agency which will develop sophisticated weapon systems and technologies
 for the purpose.
- The Cabinet Committee on Security headed by Prime Minister Narendra Modi has cleared the setting up of
 this new agency called the Defence Space Research Agency (DSRO) which has been entrusted with the task
 of creating space warfare weapon systems and technologies.
- Indian Navy's warships- INS Kolkata and INS Shakti at Busan, South Korea to participate in ADMM-PLUS:

The joint military exercise between Morocco and the US, "African Lion 2019," kicked off in southern
Morocco. The exercise marks the participation of thousands of military officers. The exercise will include

refuelling.

Indian Navy launches guided missile destroyer Imphal under Project 15B:

- The Indian Navy on Saturday launched guided missile destroyer Imphal at Mazagon Dock Shipbuilders in Mumbai.
- Imphal, the third ship under Project 15B, successfully slipped into the waters at 12:20 pm, eliciting huge cheers and slogans of "Bharat Mata Ki Jai" and Vande Mataram from the huge crowd of staffers and officials that had assembled.

China successfully launches second generation data relay satellite:

China has successfully launched the first of its new-generation data relay satellite, Tianlian II-01 into orbit
that will provide data relay, measurement, and control services for its manned spacecraft. It was launched by a
Long March-3B carrier rocket from the Xichang Satellite Launch Centre in southwest China's Sichuan
Province.

In a mission of many firsts, ISRO puts defence satellite EMISAT, 28 other satellites in orbit:

The ISRO has launched a Defence Intelligence Satellite, EMISAT in its 47th Polar Satellite Launch Vehicle
(PSLV) mission, along with 28 other customer satellites, onboard the advanced PSLV-C45 Rocket. The PSLV
C45 was launched from ISRO's Satish Dhawan Space Centre in Sriharikota. It is the first time ISRO is
launching satellites in three different orbits.

Nepal successfully launched its first satellite NepaliSat-1 into space:

- Nepal successfully launched its first satellite NepaliSat -1 into space from Virginia in the United States. The satellite, developed by two Nepalis -- Abhas Maskey and Hariram Shrestha at Japan's Kyushu Institute of Technology. NepaliSat-1 is a low orbit satellite. It will be stationed at the International Space Station for a month and then it will be sent to orbit the earth.
- The satellite will take photographs on a regular basis to gather geographical information of the country. It weighs 1.3 kilograms, making it a small satellite with limited capability.

Sri Lanka's first satellite 'Raavana-1' was launched into space:

• Sri Lanka's first satellite _Raavana-1' was launched into space from NASA's Flight Facility on Virginia's east shore. _Raavana 1' weights around 1.05 kg and the lifespan of the satellite is around one and a half years.

• The satellite was designed and built at the Kyushu Institute of Technology in Japan by two Sri Lankan research engineers.

Tesla has developed its 'largest power storage system in Asia':

 Tesla has developed its 'largest power storage system in Asia' at Osaka train station in Japan to reduce energy demand and provide emergency backup power to trains in Japan. It was Launched in partnership with Kintetsu, a railway operator in Japan's Osaka.

GAIL, BHEL tie up for development of solar power projects:

- Maharatna public sector units GAIL India Ltd and Bharat Heavy Electricals Ltd (BHEL) have inked a memorandum of understanding (MoU) for cooperation in the development of solar power projects.
- The MoU is aimed at building a closer strategic partnership between the two state-owned companies for
 jointly pursuing commercial solar power projects through participation in tariff and viability gap funding
 based competitive bidding process.
- India has set a target to achieve 100 GW of solar power by 2022 so that all citizens can have round-the-clock access to uninterrupted electricity.

Google Unveils Hybrid Cloud Platform Anthos:

 Google launched Anthos, a new open platform from Google Cloud, that lets users run applications from anywhere. Anthos allows users to run applications, unmodified, on existing on-premise hardware or on the public cloud and is based on the Cloud Services Platform that Google announced in 2018.

Japan creates first artificial crater on asteroid:

- Japanese scientists have succeeded in creating what they called the first-ever artificial crater on an asteroid, a step towards shedding light on how the solar system evolved.
- The announcement comes after the Hayabusa2 probe fired an explosive device at the Ryugu asteroid early this month to blast a crater in the surface and scoop up material, aiming to reveal more about the origins of life on Earth.

South Korea launched 5G network:

• South Korea launches the world's first fully-fledged 5G mobile networks. The system will bring smartphones near-instantaneous connectivity 20 times faster than the existing 4G allowing users to download entire movies in less than a second.

NASA astronaut to set record for longest spaceflight by a woman:

NASA astronaut Christina Koch is going to have her mission on the International Space Station (ISS)
 extended to 328 days. This would set a record for the longest single spaceflight by a woman. Koch arrived at
