INDIA OPENS WATER CLINIC FOR ELEPHANTS IN MATHURA

India has opened its first specialized hydrotherapy treatment centre for elephants suffering from arthritis, joint pain and foot ailments. It is situated in Mathura, Uttar Pradesh.

It is a collaboration of Uttar Pradesh Forest Department and the NGO (Non-Governmental Organization), Wildlife SOS. The jumbo hydrotherapy centre: It is near the Wildlife SOS' Elephant Conservation and Care Centre (ECCC), which has over 20 rescued elephants.

20TH MEETING OF THE FSDC CHAIRED BY NIRMALA SITHARAMAN HELD IN NEW DELHI

The 20th meeting on Financial Stability and Development Council (FSDC) was held in New Delhi. This was chaired under the Union Minister of Finance and Corporate Affairs, Nirmala Sitharaman. The meeting was also attended by Minister of State for Finance Anurag Thakur, RBI Governor Shaktikanta Das, and Finance Secretary Subhash Chandra Garg among others. Current global and domestic economic situation and financial stability issues including those concerning Banking and Non-Banking Financial Company (NBFC) were reviewed in the meeting.

35TH GST COUNCIL MEETING HELD IN NEW DELHI

WORLD'S LARGEST MULTI-STAGE, MULTI-PURPOSE SCHEMEKALESHWARAM LIFT IRRIGATION PROJECT INAUGURATED IN TELANGANA

The first phase of the world's largest multi-stage, multi-purpose scheme Kaleshwaram Lift Irrigation Project (KLIP) worth Rs 80,000 crore was inaugurated by the Chief Minister of Telangana Chandrashekar Rao at Medigadda in Jayashankar-Bhupalpally district near the borders with Maharashtra and Chhattisgarh

It is constructed by Megha Engineering and Infrastructure Limited (MEIL). The project, built across Godavari river, has become the world's biggest in terms of capacity

BALAKOT AIRSTRIKES CODE NAMED AS 'OPERATION BANDAR' BY IAF

The Indian Air Force mission to bomb a terrorist hideout in Pakistan's Balakot was codenamed 'Operation Bandar' (Monkey), while Indian Army had taken up massive defensive measures in case Pakistan retaliated which was codenamed as "Operation Zafran".

Modernisation and upgradation of railway stations in Indian Railways are undertaken from time to time under various modernisation schemes such as Model Station Scheme, Modern Station Scheme and Adarsh Station Scheme.

CENTRAL COMMAND CENTRE FOR AIR TRAFFIC FLOW MANAGEMENT WAS INAUGURATED BY MINISTER HARDEEP SINGH PURI IN NEW DELHI

Minister of State for Civil Aviation Hardeep Singh Puri inaugurated the Central Command Centre for Air Traffic Flow Management (C-ATFM) at Vasant Kunj, New Delhi to ensure higher standards of safety.

It was inaugurated in the presence of the Chairman of Airports Authority of India (AAI) Guruprasad Mohapatra, Board Members and senior AAI officials. India became the seventh nation to implement C-ATFM after the US, Europe, Australia, South Africa, Japan, Brazil.

AN ENTREPRENEUR VIRAL SUDHIRBHAI DESAI CHANGED UDHANA RAILWAY STATION INTO INDIA'S FIRST GREEN RAILWAY STATION

Viral Sudhirbhai Desai, a young entrepreneur from surat launched an initiative to change Udhana railway station in Gujarat into India's first green and clean railway station like Mumbai's Chhatrapati Shivaji Terminus.

RUSSIAN DEPUTY PRIME MINISTER YURY TRUTNEV'S VISIT TO INDIA

Mr. Yury Trutnev, Deputy Prime Minister of the Russian Federation and Presidential Plenipotentiary Envoy to the Far Eastern Federal District along with his delegation visited India from 15-19 June 2019. The delegation included senior officials from the Russian Ministry for Far East Development, Far East Investment and Export Agency, representatives of Russian regions, industry representatives and academia.

A HIGH-LEVEL EXPERT GROUP PRESENTED THEIR SUGGESTIONS TO ACHIEVE \$5 TRILLION ECONOMY TARGET: NITI AAYOG

ODISHA CM RELEASES FLOOD HAZARD ATLAS FOR EFFECTIVE MANAGEMENT OF FLOOD

The State Government of Odisha released a Flood Hazard Atlas for efficient management of flood in the state. It was released by the Odisha Chief Minister (CM) Naveen Patnaik. This is jointly prepared by the National Remote Sensing Centre (NRSC) of ISRO (Indian Space Research Organization) and Odisha State Disaster Management Authority (OSDAMA) analyzing data relating to flood from 2001 to 2018.

CPWD CONSTITUTED A 7 MEMBER CORE GROUP FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF VISION DOCUMENT

The Central Public Works Department (CPWD), which comes under the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA), constituted a seven-member core group chaired by Additional Director General (training & research) M K Sharma to prepare a roadmap for implementation of a five-year "vision document" (STVD) as directed by Prime Minister Narendra Modi. The other members of the group are C K Verma, Indu Gural Chaudhary, Harish Kumar, Naimuddin, Manish Kumar and Rajesh Kumar.

THE SECOND EDITION OF "HEALTHY STATES, PROGRESSIVE INDIA" REPORT RELEASED BY NITI AAYOG

The National Institution for Transforming India (NITI) Aayog released the Second Edition of "Healthy States, Progressive India" Report. It ranked States and Union territories (UTs) innovatively on their year-on-year incremental change in health outcomes and their overall performance.

It was developed by NITI Aayog with technical assistance from the World Bank in consultation with the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW).

CENTRAL GOVERNMENT MOVE TO SET UP KRISHI VIGYAN KENDRAS TO DOUBLE FARMERS' INCOME BY 2022

The Minister of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare, Narendra Singh Tomar announced that central Government has decided to use digital technology in rural India to double farmers' income by the year 2022. For this, the Government has set up 713 Krishi Vigyan Kendras (KVK) and 684 Agricultural Technology Management Agencies (ATMA) at the district level in the country for dissemination of technologies among the farming community.

JAPAN GIFTS IMPHAL PEACE MUSEUM TO MANIPUR, BUILT ON WWII MEMORIES

Japan gifted Imphal Peace Museum to Manipur to mark the 75th anniversary of the Battle of Imphal, one of the fiercest battles of the Second World War, at Maibam Lokpa Ching popularly known as Red Hill (about 20 km southwest of Imphal). The inauguration was attended by Manipur Revenue minister Karam Shyam, Japanese Ambassador to India Kenji Hiramatsu, High Commissioner of United Kingdom Dominic Asquith and TNF Chairman Yohei Sasakawa among others.

GOVERNMENT SCHOOLS TO INTRODUCE SELF DEFENCE TRAINING FOR GIRLS UNDER SAMAGRA SHIKSHA

Integrated Scheme for School Education 'Samagra Shiksha' was launched by the Department of School Education and Literacy which comes under the Ministry of Human Resource Development, effective from the academic year 2018-19. The activity of Self Defence training for girls comes under Samagra Shiksha.

SHRI MATA VAISHNO DEVI SHRINE IN JAMMU TO HAVE ITS OWN DISASTER RESPONSE FORCE BY SEPTEMBER 2020

The Mata Vaishno Devi shrine, a religious pilgrimage atop the Trikuta hills in Reasi district of Jammu & Kashmir (J&K) will get a dedicated in-house disaster response force by September 2020. The MoU (Memorandum of Understanding) was signed between the Shri Mata Vaishno Devi Shrine Board (SMVDSB) and National Disaster Response Force (NDRF) to impart

CENTRE CONSTITUTED PANEL FOR BETTER COORDINATION AMONG MINISTERS

Central Government has formed a committee for coordination among the Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas(MoPNG), the Ministry of Environment and Forest and Climate Change(MoEFCC) and the state governments after a tug of war between the two ministries. The panel formation will help in speeding up hydrocarbon exploration-related clearances.

KOREAN AMBASSADOR TO INDIA BONG-KIL SHIN SIGNED AGREEMENT WITH BMVSS AND LAUNCHED 'JAIPUR FOOT KOREA'

South Korean Ambassador to India Bong-kil Shin launched a collaborative initiative between South Korea and Bhagwan Mahaveer Viklang Sahayata Samiti (BMVSS) named 'Jaipur Foot Korea'. An agreement was also signed by the Korean Ambassador with BMVSS to provide assistance in prosthetic limbs sector.

MHA RELEASED THE RANKINGS OF POLICE STATIONS FOR 2018; RAJASTHAN TOPS THE LIST

The Kalu police station in Bikaner district of Rajasthan was ranked the best police station in the country. It was awarded the first rank for its performance in crime prevention, investigation and disposal of cases, crime detection, community policing and maintenance of law and order, women help desk facility, drinking water facility and WiFi.

AROUND 2.22 CRORE VILLAGERS RECEIVED DIGITAL EDUCATION UNDER PMGDISHA

Electronics and Information Technology Minister Mr. Ravi Shankar Prasad announced that around 2.22 crore villagers were given Digital Education under Pradhan Mantri Gramin Digital Saksharta Abhiyan (PMGDISHA). The government has enrolled 636 training partners.

UNDER PRADHAN MANTRI AWAS YOJANA SCHEME, 81,03,196 HOUSES WERE APPROVED

Minister of State for Housing and Urban Affairs, Hardeep Singh Puri announced that 81,03,196 houses were approved under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (PMAY) scheme. 47,57,987 houses are at stages of construction and 26,07,913 houses were completed or occupied.

A four-day event of 23rd Sindhu Darshan Festival 2019 celebrated at Sindhu Ghat Shey in Jammu and Kashmir's Leh from 24 to 27 June 2019.

CABINET APPROVED BILL TO FINE PEOPLE WITH RS 10,000 FOR BLOCKING AMBULANCES

The Union Cabinet chaired by the Prime Minister Narendra Modi approved the bill to fine people with Rs 10,000 for blocking ambulances. The rule is the part of Motor Vehicles (Amendment) Bill.

The Bill was approved as several cases were reported where ambulances were stuck for hours either due to agitation on roads, traffic or due to a minister's visit, which sometimes caused patients to lose their lives.

GOVERNMENT FORMS 18-MEMBER WORKING GROUP HEADED BY RAMESH CHAND, NITI AAYOG MEMBER, TO REVISE CURRENT SERIES OF WPI

Government formed a 18-member working group headed by Ramesh Chand, member of NITI (National Institution for Transforming India) Aayog, to revise current series of Wholesale Price Index (WPI) with base year 2011-12 and come up with a new Producer Price Index (PPI).

MOA SIGNED BETWEEN MINISTRY OF SHIPPING AND IIT KHARAGPUR TO SET UP CICMT

A Memorandum of Agreement (MoA) was signed between Ministry of Shipping and IIT (Indian Institute of Technology), Kharagpur to set up Centre for Inland & Coastal Maritime Technology (CICMT) at IIT Kharagpur. CICMT is the first of its kind centre in India with the focus on indigenisation of ship designing, building, and testing.

GO TRIBAL CAMPAIGN BY TRIBES INDIA LAUNCHED IN NEW DELHI

"Go Tribal Campaign" by Tribes India was launched by Minister of State for Tribal Affairs, Smt. Renuka Singh in the presence of Shri R.C. Meena, Chairman, Tribal Cooperative Marketing Development Federation of India (TRIFED), Shri Deepak Khandekar, Secretary, Ministry of Tribal Affairs and Shri Pravir Krishna, Managing Director, TRIFED in New Delhi.

MEETING OF EXPERT WORKING GROUP OF PARIS PACT INITIATIVE OF UNODC HELD IN NEW DELHI

2-day Meeting of Expert Working Group on Paris Pact Initiative on Illicit Financial Flows deriving from the trafficking of Opiates originating in Afghanistan was organised in New Delhi from June 27-28, 2019. It was hosted by the Department of Revenue, Ministry of Finance with the support of United Nations Office on Drugs & Crimes (UNODC). It was inaugurated by the Additional Secretary, Revenue Mr. Anil Kumar Jha.

CENTRE CONSTITUTED A 3-MEMBER PANEL TO RESOLVE DIFFERENCES BETWEEN SOLAR AND WIND POWER PLAYERS

The two sides of India and China have agreed to come to mutually acceptable, reasonable and fair solutions to their thorny boundary issues.

Now special representatives appointed by both China and India (From India, NSA(National Security Adviser) Ajit Doval and from China State Councilor Wang-Yi)in order to rework the framework for the settlement of boundary.

ALL GRAM PANCHAYATS BROADBAND CONNECTIVITY UNDER BHARATNET BY MARCH 2020

Electronics and IT Minister, Ravi Shankar Prasad stated that all gram panchayats(GPs) in the country will be connected with the high-speed broadband under BharatNet project by March 2020.

HIGH-LEVEL GROUP HEADED BY DR. SURJIT S. BHALLA RECOMMENDATIONS FOR TRADE AND POLICY

The Union ministry of commerce had constituted a high-level advisory group headed by economist Dr. Surjit S. Bhalla, member of the Prime Minister's Economic Advisory Council on Foreign trade policy for ways to boost India's share and importance in global merchandise and services trade.

FSSAI PLANS RED COLOR-CODING LABEL FOR SUGARY AND SALTY FOODS

As per the draft regulation issued by the Food Safety and Standards Authority(FSSAI) (Labelling and Display regulation) of India Packaged food companies will be required to label high fat, sugar and salt content levels on the front side of the package with "red-color-coding".

INFANT MORTALITY RATE (IMR) IN INDIA FALLS BUT THE PACE OF CHANGE SLOWS

According to the sample Registration system (SRS), India's infant mortality rate declined by 9 positions from 42 in 2012 to 33 in 2017. Madhya Pradesh and Assam had the worst IMR of 47 and 44 respectively while Kerala and Tamil Nadu recorded the lowest IMR of 10 and 16 respectively.

UNEMPLOYMENT RATE IN INDIA AT 6.1% IN 2017-18

According to a survey conducted by National Sample Survey Office (NSSO) between July 2017 and June 2018 covering 4.3 lakh people revealed that the unemployment rate was about 6.1% in

2017-18, highest in 45 year since 1972-73. The unemployment rate in rural areas was about 5.3% while in urban areas it was about 7.8%.

INDIA HAS 20 HEALTH WORKERS PER 10,000 PEOPLE: NSSO STUDY

A recent study based on the National Sample Survey Organization (NSSO) data, India has 20.6 health workers per 10,000 people. This is less than the World health Organization's (WHO) minimum overreach of 22.8 per 10,000 people. ural areas with 71% of India's population have only 36% of health workers.

KASTURIRANGAN COMMITTEE SUBMITTED THE DRAFT NATIONAL EDUCATION POLICY TO THE NEW UNION HRD MINISTER RAMESH POKHARIYAL

The K. Kasturirangan Committee has submitted the 484-pages draft report of National Education Policy to the new Union Human Resource Development Minister Ramesh Pokhariyal. The report on the National Education Policy has been put on the Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD)'s website for suggestions from the public till June 30.

CABINET APPROVED A NEW INITIATIVE TO CONTROL FMD AND BRUCELLOSIS TO SUPPORT LIVESTOCK REARING FARMERS

The Cabinet, first since the outcome of the 2019 Lok Sabha election, approved a new initiative to control Foot and Mouth Disease (FMD) and Brucellosis to support livestock rearing farmers The FMD and Brucellosis is a common threat among livestock like cow-bulls, buffaloes, sheeps, goats, pigs etc. The Cabinet sanctioned Rs 13,343 crores for the implantation of the initiative.

CABINET APPROVED THE EXTENSION OF PM-KISAN YOJANA TO ALL ELIGIBLE FARMERS

The newly formed Union Cabinet has given its consent for the extension of the Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi Yojana ((PM-KISAN) to all eligible farmer families, irrespective of the size of their landholding. INDIA'S DATA USAGE PER SMARTPHONE IS THE HIGHEST IN THE WORLD AT 9.8GB PER MONTH

As per the Ericsson Mobility Report of June 2019 edition, India's data usage per smartphone was the highest in the world at 9.8 Giga Byte (GB) per month up to December 31, 2018. It is set to double to 18 GB by 2024. Indian smartphone users are willing to pay more than 66% premium for futuristic 5G services.

North East Asia stood at the second place with 7.1 GB per month and North America at third with 7 GB. West Asia and Africa region had the lowest data consumption at 3 GB per month.

The membership was admitted into the global money laundering watchdog after the group's Annual General Meeting in Orlando, Florida where FATF celebrated the 30th anniversary of its first meeting which was held in Paris in 1989.

FIVE COUNTRIES FROM ASIA AND CENTRAL AMERICA HAD NO CASES OF MALARIA IN 2018: WHO

According to the report by World Health Organization (WHO), Four countries from Asia includes China, Iran, Malaysia and Timor-Leste and one country from Central America, El Salvador had malaria-free cases in 2018 and the report confirms that world is on a track to reach malaria elimination by 2020.

MEXICO BECAME THE FIRST COUNTRY TO RATIFY THE TRADE DEAL TO REPLACE NAFTA

The United Arab Emirates' Central Bank in Abu Dhabi announced that it's Financial Intelligence Unit (FIU) launched a new reporting platform 'goAML' (global operations Anti-Money Laundering). It is developed by the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime (UNODC) to curb organised financial crimes.

NEPALESE NATIONALS MUST HAVE A VISA TO ENTER INDIA VIA PAKISTAN, CHINA, HONG KONG AND MACAU

The Nepalese Embassy in New Delhi issued a notice stating that Nepalese nationals must have a visa if they are entering India from Pakistan, China, Hong Kong, and Macau. This was done to increase security in the country.

FEDERAL BANK RAISES RS 300 CRORE THROUGH A PRIVATE PLACEMENT OF BASEL III COMPLIANT TIER II BONDS

Kochi based Federal Bank announced that it has raised Rs 300 crore through Basel-III compliant bonds for improving their risk management techniques and to address the growing risks.

PAYMENTS RELATED DATA TO BE STORED ONLY IN INDIA: RBI

The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) in its frequently asked questions (FAQ) section stated that the data related to payment transactions must be stored in systems of the country and if any information is processed abroad, it should be deleted from their systems and brought back to India not later than one business day or 24 hours from the payment processing, whichever is earlier. The clarification was sought by the Payment System Operators (PSOs) on the issue of data localization.

GOVERNMENT LOWERS INTEREST RATES ON SMALL SAVING SCHEMES BY 0.1% FOR SEPTEMBER QUARTER

- The schemes include Public provident fund (PPF), National Savings Certificate (NSC), Kisan Vikas Patra(KVP), Sukanya Samriddhi Account, Senior Citizens Savings Scheme (SCSS).
- PPF&NSC: For the July-September quarter, PPF and National Savings Certificate will fetch an annual interest rate of 7.9% as compared to 8% earlier.
- KVP: Kisan Vikas Patra will yield 7.6 percent with a maturity of 113 months. At present, the interest rate on KVP is 7.7 percent and maturity is 112 months.
- The girl child savings scheme: Sukanya Samriddhi Account will offer 8.4 percent from 8.5 percent.
- SCSS: Senior Citizens Savings Scheme will offer 8.6 percent from 8.7 percent.
- Term deposits of 1-3 years will offer an interest rate of 6.9 percent will be paid quarterly, while the five-year quarterly pegged at 7.7 percent and for recurring 7.2 percent from the existing rate of 7.3 percent.

RBI RELAXED THE LEVERAGE RATIO (LR) FOR BANKS TO HELP BANKS EXPAND LENDING

The RBI (Reserve Bank of India) relaxed the leverage ratio (LR) for banks in a bid to help them expand their lending activities. The leverage ratio (LR) reduced to 4% for Domestic Systemically Important Banks (DSIBs) and 3.5% for other banks with effective from October 1, 2019.

The World Bank and the Government of India signed a loan agreement of \$400 Million for the Program Towards Elimination of Tuberculosis(TB), which kills approximately half a million people in India every year. The program will cover nine States of India.

It will also support the government's National Strategic Plan to end TB in India by 2025.

STATE BANK OF INDIA TO INTRODUCE REPO-LINKED HOME LOAN PRODUCT FROM JULY 1

State Bank of India (SBI) announced to introduce repo-linked home loan product from July 1, 2019. It has become the first bank to offer this facility. It means any changes in the key interest rate by the central bank would be passed on directly to the customers. The home loans up to Rs 75 lakh will be priced at 2.65% over the repo rate of 5.75% resulting in the interest rate of 8.40%.

PAYTM PAYMENTS BANK AHEAD OF MAJOR BANKS IN DIGITAL TRANSACTION TARGET WITH 501.16 CRORE DIGITAL TRANSACTIONS

Paytm Payments Bank with 501.16 crore digital transactions for the financial year 2019-20 is ahead of major banks including HDFC Bank, Industrial Credit, and Investment Corporation of India (ICICI) Bank and Punjab National Bank (PNB) in digital transaction target set by the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY).

KOTAK MAHINDRA BANK WAS PENALIZED WITH RS 2 CRORE BY RESERVE BANK OF INDIA FOR NOT MEETING OWNERSHIP RULES

Reserve Bank of India has penalized Kotak Mahindra Bank with Rs. 2 crores for not furnishing details about the shareholding of its promoter and its plans for complying with stake dilution norms.RBI has mandated the bank to reduce its promoter shareholding to 20 percent by December 31, 2018, and to 15 percent by March 2022.

MAX LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY LAUNCHED 'MY PROTECTION QUOTIENT' TOOL

Max Life Insurance Company launched a unique proprietary tool named 'My Protection Quotient' (MyPQ) to ensure financial protection in the country. It had earlier launched 'India Protection Quotient' survey in association with Kantar IMRB to understand where India stands with regards to life and term insurance ownership. It also has dedicated 6th of every month as 'Protection day' and MyPQ was launched on Second protection day.

RBI EASED REGULATIONS FOR BSBD ACCOUNTS

Nation's apex bank Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has relaxed the regulations for Basic Savings Bank Deposit (BSBD) Accounts aka "no-frills" accounts as a part of the financial inclusion drive. BSBDA holders will get certain minimum facilities, free of charge.

SASHAKT COMMITTEE RECOMMENDS RBI'S CHANGES IN INTER-CREDITOR AGREEMENT (ICA) FRAMEWORK

Sashakt Committee headed by Punjab National Bank non-executive Chairman Sunil Mehta has stated that the new guidelines of RBI regarding the mandation of Inter-Creditor Agreement (ICA) framework is a right move to resolve non-performing assets (NPAs or bad loans). In the first week of June 2019, RBI has issued revised guidelines for resolution of stressed assets named "Prudential framework for resolution of stressed assets", which has mandated the lenders to review the accounts within 30 days of default and initiate a resolution plan or Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code (IBC) process before the default, among others.

CENTRE HAS EXTENDED THE RS 1.6 BILLION AID TO NEPAL FOR REBUILDING EARTHQUAKE-HIT HOUSES

The Indian government has extended the financial aid of 1.6 billion Nepalese rupees to Nepal for the rebuilding of houses in Nuwakot and Gorkha districts, which were damaged in the devastating earthquake in 2015. The cheque for the same was handed over by India's ambassador to Nepal Manjeev Singh Puri to Finance Secretary of Nepal Rajan Khanal.

NPAS PLUNGED TO 9.30% IN FY'19, BELOW RBI ESTIMATE

As per the Crisil report, the overall non-performing assets (NPAs) stock has declined at a great pace to 9.3% in March 2019 in comparison to the 11.5% in March 2018. This decline is more than the RBI's (Reserve Bank of India) estimate. This shows a positive sign of recovery from the Non-performing asset load as the NPA ratio of both public and private sector banks showed a half-yearly decline, for the first time since March 2015.

RBI FORMED A COMMITTEE HEADED BY VG KANNAN, IBA CHIEF TO REVIEW ATM PRICING

The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) constituted 6-member committee headed by VG Kannan, Chief Executive of Indian Banks' Association (IBA) to review ATM pricing. It will review the existing interchange fee and pricing structures to reduce prices for customers on Automated Teller Machines (ATM) transactions with a broader objective to improve rural penetration of teller machines

A PENALTY OF RS.11.25 LAKH IMPOSED ON ZIPCASH, YES BANK BY RBI

The Reserve Bank of India slapped a monetary penalty Rs. 11.25 lakh each on Private sector lender 'Yes Bank' and Online Wallet Service, 'ZipCash Card Services' for violating PPI (prepaid payment instrument) norms pertaining to issuance and operation of PPIs.

IDBI BANK AND MAX BUPA SIGN BANCASSURANCE CORPORATE AGENCY AGREEMENT

Industrial Development Bank of India (IDBI) Bank and Max Bupa, a Standalone Health Insurer (SAHI) signed a Bancassurance corporate agency agreement. For the first time, IDBI Bank became an on-boarded corporate agent for Max Bupa under open architecture. It will also install 'Infinity', a proprietary digital platform. Through this, the customers of IDBI Bank can purchase the product of their choice instantly and access their policy documents at the bank branch

EXIM BANK SIGNED \$245 MILLION LOAN AGREEMENT WITH GHANA & MOZAMBIQUE FOR AGRICULTURAL AND RAILWAY PROJECTS

The central bank of the country, the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) notified that Export-Import Bank of India (Exim Bank) will provide Line of Credit (LoC) worth \$245 million to Ghana and Mozambique for agricultural and railway projects. The agreement is effective from June 3, 2019. Under the LoC, the terminal utilisation period is 60 months after the scheduled completion date of the project.

ZESTMONEY IN PARTNERSHIP WITH DIGIT INSURANCE TO OFFER EMI INSURANCE

ZestMoney, a Bengaluru based digital lending startup, in partnership with Digit Insurance announced to offer EMI (Equated Monthly Installment) insurance to the company's five million customers. The aim of the partnership is to relieve its customers of debt in case of unforeseen circumstances.

EDELWEISS AND BANK OF BARODA TIED UP FOR MSME LOANS

Bank of Baroda (BoB) and ECL Finance, the flagship non-banking financial company of Edelweiss Group, signed an agreement to form a strategic partnership to explore co-lending opportunities. They will provide timely delivery of credit to customers at a significantly lower cost.

FUNDZBAZAR LAUNCHED 'SELFIEWALA KYC' FEATURE FOR FIRST-TIME MUTUAL FUND INVESTORS

FundzBazar, an online mutual fund investment platform launched by Prudent, has initiated 'Selfiewala KYC' feature for the first-time mutual fund investors. This feature allows the investors to carry out the IPV (In-Person Verification) by uploading a video and a selfie which in turn speeds up the KYC process and saves time.

IRDAI HIKED THIRD PARTY INSURANCE PREMIUM FOR SMALL-MEDIUM CARS FROM JUNE 16, 2019

The Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority of India (IRDAI) hiked the Third Party (TP) motor insurance premium for small and medium private cars by 12-12.5% for 2019-20. The rates are applicable from June 16, 2019. TP premium for two-wheelers and heavy vehicles was also increased. These powers which are provided to IRDAI are mentioned under Section 14 (2) (i) of the IRDA Act, 1999.

RBI ASKED BANKS TO GROUT ATMS TO A WALL, PILLAR, OR FLOOR IN ORDER TO INCREASE SECURITY

The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) asked the banks to grout Automated Teller Machines (ATMs) to a wall, pillar, or floor by September 30, 2019 in order to mitigate risks in ATM operations and increase security. Exceptions were given to the ATMs installed in high secured premises. The measure was adopted by the RBI after the recommendations made by the Committee on Currency Movement (CCM) under the chairmanship of DK Mohanty which was formed in 2016.

AS PER RBI, BANK FRAUDS WORTH RS. 2.05 LAKH CRORE REPORTED IN THE LAST 11 YEARS

The central bank of the country, the Reserve Bank of India's (RBI) data revealed that 53,334 fraud cases worth Rs. 2.05 lakh crore hit the banks in India in the last 11 fiscal years i.e, between 2008-09 and 2018-19.

SEBI TIGHTENED RATING GUIDELINES TO ENHANCE STANDARDS

The Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) issued stricter norms for rating agencies to enhance standards. This move comes after a series of defaults at Infrastructure Leasing & Financial Services Limited (IL & FS) in 2018. It introduced disclosure of rating sensitivities in its press releases. It will help the end-users to understand the factors that would have the potential to impact the creditworthiness of the entity.

ADB SANCTIONS RS 1,650CR INFRA PROJECTS IN TRIPURA

The Asian Development Bank (ADB) has approved a project submitted by the Urban Development Department (UDD) of Tripura amounting to Rs. 1650 crore for overall infrastructure development of seven districts headquarter towns of Tripura. The ADB will give 80 percent of 1650 crore as grant-in-aid and the State Government of Tripura will have to repay back only 20 percent loan in due course of time.

AS PER RBI, DIGITAL TRANSACTIONS WILL RISE FOUR TIMES BY 2021

The Reserve Bank of India in its report "Payment and Settlement: The Plumbing in the Architecture of India's Financial System", stated that the digital transactions till March 2019 witnessed tremendous growth and they will rise by four times from Rs 2,069 crore in December 2018 to Rs 8,707 crore in December 2021. In 2018-19, total digital transactions in volume terms recorded a growth rate of 58.8%.

JAMMU AND KASHMIR BANK BROUGHT UNDER RTI, CVC GUIDELINES

The Board of Directors (BoD) of Jammu & Kashmir Bank under the chairmanship of the bank's Interim Chairman and Managing Director (MD) R.S. Chhibber decided to bring the bank under Jammu and Kashmir (J&K) Right to Information (RTI) Act, 2009 and the Central Vigilance Commission (CVC) guidelines with effect from June 17, 2019. The decision was taken after receiving directions from the State Government, which owns 59% of the bank's shares.

RBI PANEL ON MSMES HEADED BY U K SINHA RECOMMENDED TO DOUBLE COLLATERAL-FREE LOANS LIMIT TO RS 20 LAKH

The 8 member panel on Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs), constituted by the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) in January 2019, headed by the former Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) Chairman U K Sinha submitted its report to RBI Governor Shaktikanta Das suggested doubling collateral-free loans for MSMEs to Rs 20 lakh from Rs 10 lakh. The panel was formed to suggest long-term measures for the economic and financial sustainability of the MSME sector.

NHB ISSUED STRICTER NORMS ON HFCS' CAPITAL ADEQUACY RATIOS

The National Housing Bank (NHB) has tightened the norms on leverage and capital adequacy ratio for Housing Finance Companies (HFCs). It mandated the HFCs to reduce their total borrowings in a phased manner to not more than 12 times(at present 16 times) of their Net-Owned Funds (NOF) as on March 31, 2022. Life Insurance Corporation (LIC) Housing Finance is the only HFC to have the highest leverage ratio of 14 times of NOF.

FLIPKART REVAMPS MSME SELLER FINANCING PROGRAMME 'GROWTH CAPITAL'

E-commerce firm Flipkart has revamped its Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) seller financing programme 'Growth Capital' in order to empower MSMEs across the country. The program enables financial inclusion and independence for MSMEs who operate online.

MAX LIFE INSURANCE LAUNCHED 'MAX LIFE SMART TERM PLAN'

Max Life Insurance Company Limited, one of the country's leading life insurance companies, launched customizable 'Max Life Smart Term Plan'. It will offer customers the flexibility to customize their own protection solution through the selection from a wide range of benefits and features. The United States (US) overtook China to become India's largest goods trading partner in 2018-19. Trade surplus of India with the US declined to \$16.8 billion from \$21.2 billion for 2017-18.

The Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) framed a working group headed by NSE Clearing Ltd to review the current framework of margins in the futures and options segment.

It will submit its recommendations to the Secondary Market Advisory Committee.

SKYLARK DRONES AND THROTTLE AEROSPACE SYSTEMS GET DGCA NOD TO FLY

The Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) gave its approval to Skylark Drones and Throttle Aerospace Systems (TAS) of Bengaluru to launch its drones as they are compliant with the NP-NT (No permission – No take-off) protocol under the "Digital Sky" regulatory framework for drones, which came into effect on December 1, 2018.

NABCB GETS APAC CERTIFICATE FOR PERSONNEL CERTIFICATION BODIES IN SINGAPORE

The National Accreditation Board for Certification Bodies (NABCB), has got its international recognition for its accreditation programme for personnel certification bodies. It was held in Asia Pacific Accreditation Cooperation (APAC) Annual Meetings 2019 in Singapore.

NITI AAYOG PLANS TO CONVERT THREE-WHEELERS TO EVS BY 2023 AND 2-WHEELERS BELOW 150CC BY 2025

National Institution for Transforming India (NITI) Aayog organized the first meeting with manufacturers and start-up Electric Vehicle (EV) makers, during which NITI Aayog planned for the transition of three-wheelers by 2023 and two-wheelers with an engine capacity less than 150 cc (Cubic Centimeter) by 2025 to full Electric Vehicles (EVs). It asked the conventional two and three-wheeler makers to suggest concrete steps towards transition to electric mobility keeping in mind 2025 deadline, within two weeks.

Indian Railway Stations Development Corporation (IRSDC) signed 2 Memorandum of Agreements (MoAs) on 'Railway Station Redevelopment' for the renovation of 22 railway stations.

NATIONAL FREIGHT INDEX (NFI) LAUNCHED BY RIVIGO LOGISTICS

In order to bring transparency in the road-freight marketplace, an Indian technology company based in Gurgaon, Rivigo which owns 3,000 trucks 5,000 drivers launched the National Freight Index (NFI) which will provide unrestricted access of live freight rates for different lanes and vehicles across the country.Logistics account for nearly 14% of India's GDP.

NTPC AND PGCIL SIGN MOU TO FORM A JOINT VENTURE TO ENTER POWER DISTRIBUTION BUSINESS

National Thermal Power Corporation (NTPC) and PowerGrid Corporation of India Limited (PGCIL) signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) to set up a Joint Venture (JV) the National Electricity Distribution Company Limited (NEDCL). It will undertake the business for distribution of electricity in distribution circles in various states and Union Territories (UTs) and other related activities.

According to the survey, "The Periodic Labour Force Survey (PLFS) for 2017-18" by National Sample Survey Organization (NSSO), there are huge variations among the states in terms of the unemployment rate. The overall unemployment rate pegs at 6.1%.

CAD INCREASED TO 2.1% OF GDP

The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) stated that India's Current Account Deficit (CAD) increased to \$57.2 billion or 2.1% of the Gross Domestic Product (GDP) in FY19 as against 1.8% of 2018 which stood at \$48.7 billion. It was the highest in 6 years on due to higher trade deficit caused by high crude oil imports.

INDIAN ECONOMY LOST ITS SPOT AS WORLD'S FASTEST GROWING ECONOMY TO CHINA

Indian economy lost its spot as the world's fastest-growing economy to China. As per Reuters survey, it registered 6.3% annual growth in the January-March quarter, its slowest pace in six quarters. China recorded a growth of 6.4% in the March Quarter. Indicators like automobile sales, rail freight, petroleum product consumption, domestic air traffic and imports registered a slowdown in domestic consumption.

GOVERNMENT MET THE FISCAL DEFICIT TARGET OF 3.4% FOR FY 2018-19

Government has met the fiscal deficit target of 3.4% for the Financial Year 2018-19. The fiscal deficit stood at 3.39% against the estimated rate of 3.4%. The data was released by the Controller General of Accounts (CGA). It was met through a reduction in government spending, which also contributed to GDP growth slowing to 5.8% in the fourth quarter of FY19

HORTICULTURE PRODUCTION REGISTERED AN UPWARD GROWTH AT 314.87 MILLION TONNE IN 2018-19

Horticulture production registered a rise to 314.87 million tonne in 2018-19 which was 1.01% higher than horticulture production in 2017-18. In the previous year, the output was 311.71 million tonnes. The crop year in India is from July-June. The

India's top oil and gas producer, ONGC (Oil and Natural Gas Corporation) has become India's most profitable Public sector undertaking after surpassing Indian Oil Corp (IOC) while Reliance has been India's most profitable company for the fourth year in a row with its net profit of Rs 39,588 crore in FY19.

AS PER THE GFI STUDY, INDIA LOST \$13 BILLION IN REVENUE COLLECTIONS DUE TO TRADE MISINVOICING

According to a study by think-tank Global Financial Integrity (GFI), India lost \$13 billion in revenue collections due to trade misinvoicing in 2016. It amounted to 5.5% of total revenue collections. The study estimated that the value of the trade gap for misinvoiced goods equaled to \$74 billion or 12% of the country's total trade of \$617 billion in 2016

FDI IN SERVICES SECTOR ROSE BY 36.5% IN 2018-19

According to the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT), the Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) grew at 36.5% amounting to \$9.15 billion in 2018-19. Services sector comprises of finance, banking, insurance, outsourcing, R&D, courier, tech testing and analysis. In 2017-18, FDI of the service sector was \$6.7 billion.

WORLD BANK CUTS GLOBAL GROWTH FORECAST FOR 2019 TO 2.6% AND IT RETAINS INDIA'S FY19 GROWTH FORECAST AT 7.5%

World Bank in its semiannual report "Global Economic Prospect (GEP)" slashed global forecast for 2019 to 2.6% as compared to 2.9% in January this year. World Bank in its report "Global Economic Prospects report" retained India's growth forecast at 7.5% for the next two Fiscal years , FY2019 and FY20 (April 1, 2019 to March 31, 2020) as it also cuts the global economic expansion by 0.3%.

AAI (AIRPORTS AUTHORITY OF INDIA) SIGNS TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE PACT WITH BOEING

The National Airports body Airports Authority of India (AAI) signed technical assistance agreement with American multinational corporate, Boeing to jointly develop a 10-year roadmap which will improve flexible use of airspace, enhance communication, surveillance and help to maintain efficient aircraft operations.

US President Donald Trump signed a proclamation to withdraw Generalized System of Preferences(GSP) scheme on \$5.6 billion exports from India, effective from June 5, 2019.

GST COLLECTIONS CROSSED RS 1 LAKH CRORE MARK FOR THREE CONSECUTIVE MONTH

The Goods And Services tax collection for May 2019 is Rs 1,00,289 crore, however, this is lesser than Rs 1,13,865 crore collected in April, an all-time high since the rollout of GST in July 2017. This is the third consecutive time for GST to cross Rs 1 Lakh. The revenue in May 2019 is 2.21% greater than the monthly average of GST revenue in fiscal 2018-19.

DELHI METRO IS INDIA'S FIRST PROJECT TO RECEIVE POWER FROM WASTE-TO-ENERGY

Delhi Metro became India's the first ever project to receive power from a waste-to-energy plant. The Delhi Metro Rail Corporation (DMRC) started receiving 2 MW power from a 12 MW capacity waste-to-energy plant set up in Ghazipur, Uttar Pradesh.

CII UNVEILED NEW INDEX TO MEASURE FISCAL PERFORMANCE

Confederation of Indian Industry (CII) has launched a new Index to measure fiscal performance titled 'Fiscal Performance Index' (FPI). It uses multiple indicators to assess the quality of budgets presented by the Centre and state governments. FPI has been constructed using the United Nations Development Programme's (UNDP) Human Development Index methodology. It comprises of 6 components. Read full details here:

INDIA SIGNED RS 300-CRORE DEAL WITH ISRAEL TO BUY MORE 100 SPICE BOMBS

The Indian Air Force (IAF) inked Rs 300-crore deal with the Israeli government to buy more than 100 SPICE bombs (Balakot bombs). The bombs were used to attack the Madrasa of Jaish-e-Mohammed in Balakot, Pakistan, on February 26, 2019. INDIA'S GDP GROWTH MAY EXPAND TO 7.2 PERCENT IN 2019-20: GOLDMAN SACHS

According to American multinational banking firm, Goldman Sachs, India's economic growth is estimated to rise to 7.2 percent in 2019-20. It will be driven by lower oil prices, political

stability, and removal of infrastructure bottlenecks. The report came a day after the policy review by RBI, in which policy rates were cut by 0.25 percent to increase growth.

BUSINESS CONFIDENCE INDEX DROPS 9.1% IN Q4 OF 2018-19: NCAER

According to a recent survey by the National Council of Applied Economic Research (NCAER), Business confidence index (BCI) of India Inc slipped 9.1 percent in the fourth quarter Q4 of the financial year 2018-19. Meanwhile, the Political Confidence Index (PCI) of businesses has increased by 12.1% on a quarterly basis in Q4.

Recently, Hero MotoCorp becomes the first two-wheeler manufacturer to receive BS6 Certification for its Hero Splendor iSmart.

IMPORTS FROM PAKISTAN TO INDIA DECLINED BY 92% IN MARCH 2019 TO \$2.84 MILLION

Imports from Pakistan to India declined by 92% in March 2019 to \$2.84 million due to the imposition of 200% customs duties on all products after Pulwama terror attack. India had hiked the customs duty to 200% on all goods imported from Pakistan including cotton, fresh fruits, cement, petroleum products and mineral ore on February 16, 2019. It had also revoked the MFN (Most Favoured Nation) status which was given to Pakistan in 1996.

SEBI RELEASED A DISCUSSION PAPER FOR INFORMANT MECHANISM RELATED TO INSIDER TRADING

Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) released a discussion paper for informant mechanism related to insider trading. The proposed amendments to the SEBI (Prohibition of Insider Trading) Regulations, 2015 will provide absolute confidentiality with appropriate safeguards. Capital market regulator announced that genuine whistleblowers could get monetary reward up to Rs 1 crore as well as amnesty from regulatory action

DCC APPROVED TO IMPOSE PENALTY ON AIRTEL, VODAFONE IDEA

The highest decision-making body of the Department of Telecom (DoT), Digital Communications Commission (DCC) approved to levy penalties on Bharti Airtel Ltd and Vodafone Idea Ltd for denial of interconnection to Reliance Jio Infocomm Ltd when it had entered the market in 2016. Reliance Jio had complained that its subscribers were unable to call other networks as its rivals did not release sufficient number of Points of Interconnect (PoI).

FITCH REDUCES INDIA GROWTH FORECAST FOR FY20 FROM 6.8% TO 6.6%

Fitch reduced India's growth forecast for the current fiscal year (FY20) from 6.8% to 6.6% due to the slow down of manufacturing and agriculture sectors over the past years.

INDIAN RAILWAYS AND REL SIGNED MOU FOR MODERNISATION OF SIGNALLING SYSTEM ON FOUR SECTIONS

Indian Railways signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with RailTel Enterprises Limited (REL), a wholly-owned subsidiary company of RailTel Corporation of India Ltd, to upgrade its signalling system on 4 busiest sections. It includes Automatic Train Protection System with Long Term Evolution (LTE) based Mobile Train Radio Communication System (MTRC) along with the provision of Electronic Interlocking (indoor) wherever required.

SCIENTISTS DEVELOP CANCER CELL DETECTION 'DOTS' FROM COAL IN ASSAM

In Assam, a team of Scientists from CSIR-NEIST(Council of Scientific & Industrial Research-North East Institute of Science and Technology) have developed a chemical process that turns 'dirty' coal into biomedical 'Carbon Quantum Dots (CQDs)' which helps in detection of cancer cells.

For producing CQDs, cheap, low-quality and high-sulfur coals used by the team led by Binoy Kumar Saikia and Tonkeswar Das for a patent of their chemical method. The details have been published in the Journal of Photochemistry and Photobiology.

RESEARCHERS FROM JAPAN DEVELOPED A NEW TYPE OF COOLING VEST FOR SPORTS ATHLETES

Japanese researchers from Hiroshima University have developed a new type of cooling vest for sports athletes which helps them to compete safely in sweltering summer conditions. The aim of the vest is to cool the athletes' upper-body skin which can decrease heart rate and temperature of their neck and skin.

HERBAL DRUG TO TREAT LEUCODERMA DEVELOPED BY DRDO SCIENTIST HEMANT PANDEY

Hemant Pandey, a senior scientist from Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO), developed 'Lukoskin', an herbal drug to treat leucoderma (also called 'vitiligo'), a condition in which white patches develop on the skin.

NASA'S CURIOSITY ROVER DETECTS HIGH AMOUNTS OF METHANE ON MARS

The US (United States) space agency, NASA's (National Aeronautics and Space Administration) Curiosity rover has discovered the high amounts of methane gas on Mars that indicates life on the red planet.

SPACEX LAUNCHED HEFTY ROCKET WITH 24 RESEARCH SATELLITES

Space Exploration Technologies Corp (SpaceX) launched a hefty rocket with 24 payload military and scientific research satellites with a deep space atomic clock, solar sail, clean and green rocket fuel, and even human ashes, including an astronaut.

'BUMBLE' BECAME THE FIRST ASTROBEE ROBOT TO FLY UNDER ITS OWN POWER IN SPACE

National Aeronautics and Space Administration's (NASA) Astrobee Robot "Bumble" became the first Astrobee robot to fly under its own power in space. It will help researchers in examining the new technologies in zero gravity and assist astronauts to perform routine work in the International Space Station (ISS).

INDIA SCRAPED \$500 MN ARMS DEAL WITH ISRAEL

India scraped \$500 million arms deal with Israel for the purchase of Spike anti-tank missiles from defence contractor Rafael Advanced Defense Systems. This was done after Defence Research & Development Organisation (DRDO) claimed that it could deliver an alternative with a partnership with VEM technologies Ltd within two years.

ESA AND NASA TEST LUNAR EVACUATION SYSTEM TO SAVE THE LIVES OF ASTRONAUTS

American Space Agency, NASA (National Aeronautics and Space Administration) astronauts tested a prototype Lunar Evacuation System Assembly (LESA) designed by European Space Agency (ESA). It was tested as part of NASA's NEEMO 23 (Extreme Environment Mission Operations) mission to assist in astronaut rescue missions on the surface of Moon.

Ahead of International yoga day celebrated on June 21, the ministry of AYUSH has launched yoga locator - an app to locate yoga events and centers providing training and instructor within the users range. This app is a map-based application which allows the instructor to register themselves and reach out to users.

IIT-MADRAS UNVEILED DATA PLATFORM TO IMPROVE EFFICIENCY OF GOVERNMENT INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT

The indian institute of technology (iit) madras has launched a data platform of 'integrated database on infrastructure projects' (idip) to improve the efficiency of government Infrastructure Development. The development partner for the project is Akara Research and Technologies. It was launched on May 29, 2019 at the 15th World Conference on Transport Research (WCTR) held at IIT Bombay in a special session on Public-Private Partnership(PPP) in Indian Transport Sector.

ISS SPACEWALK SUCCESSFULLY CARRIED OUT FOR 217TH TIME

International Space Station (ISS) have successfully carried out 217th spacewalk by two Russian space agency Roscosmos' cosmonauts for support, maintenance and upgrade. The spacewalk was done by Expedition 59 Commander Oleg Kononenko and Flight Engineer Alexey Ovchinin.

ARMY COMMISSIONED AIR QUALITY MONITOR AT FORT WILLIAM AS A PART OF 'GO GREEN' INITIATIVE

Army commissioned "Continuous Ambient Air Quality Monitoring System (CAAQMS)", an air quality monitor, at Fort William Military Station, Kolkata, as a part of 'Go Green' initiative. It monitors air pollution on a real-time basis. CAAQMS displays wind speed, direction, ambient temperature, relative humidity, solar radiation, barometric pressure, and rain gauge.

INDIAN NAVY DEPLOYED ANTI-PIRACY PATROL

Indian Navy has deployed its P-8 India(P-8I) long-range maritime surveillance aircraft for anti-piracy sorties from Salalah in Oman to patrol the Gulf of Aden and other piracy prone areas. This is an expansion of its Mission Based Deployments(MBD) in the Indian Ocean Region (IOR) to keep them safe

SCIENTISTS DISCOVERED NEW SPECIES OF 'PADDY FROG' FROM NORTHEAST INDIA

Scientists from Delhi University and the Wildlife Institute of India along with researchers from Indonesia and the US found a new species of 'paddy frog' from Northeast India, primarily Cachar district of Assam. The study was published in PeerJ, a peer-reviewed journal. The new species of 'paddy frog' has been named 'aishani' or aisani, means Northeast in Sanskrit. Its scientific name is Micryletta aishani.

TWO NEW SPECIES OF 'TWEEZER-BEAKED HOPPING RATS' DISCOVERED IN PHILIPPINES

Researchers from the University of Utah or Utah Natural History Museum, the University of Kansas, the University of the Philippines, and Louisiana State University have discovered two new species of the tweezer-beaked hopping rats or 'shrew-rats on mountains in the Philippines' island of Luzon. The study was published in the Journal of Mammalogy. The new species are named Rhynchomys labo (Labo shrew-rat) and Rhynchomys mingan (Mingan shrew-rat).

596 NEW SPECIES INCLUDE 224 OF PLANTS AND 372 OF ANIMALS DISCOVERED FROM INDIA IN 2018

Botanical Survey of India (BSI) and the Zoological Survey of India (ZSI) have published the details about documented 596 new species of flora and fauna from India in Plant Discoveries 2018 and Animal Discoveries 2018. It comprised of 372 new species of fauna and 224 new species of flora. Kerala recorded the highest number of discoveries with 59 species.

GOOGLE MAP LAUNCHED NEW PUBLIC TRANSPORT FEATURES IN INDIA

A web mapping service, Google map launched three India-First features targeted at Public transport users to access public transport easily. Google map users now can see the bus travel times from live traffic data across 10 cities, get to know the real-time train status on the platform as well as get commute suggestions that combine public transport and auto-rickshaws.

FOR THE FIRST TIME, CHINA LAUNCHED "LONG MARCH 11 ROCKET ", A ROCKET TO SPACE FROM A SHIP AT SEA

For the first time, China's National Space Administration (CNSA) successfully launched "Long March 11 rocket", a rocket to space from a ship at sea. It was launched from a platform on a large semi-submersible barge in the Yellow Sea. China joined the U.S. and Russia as the 3 global powers with proven ability to launch rockets into space from the sea.

ARMY LAUNCHED RODRA WEBSITE TO ADDRESS VETERANS' ISSUES

Army launched an online platform, Retired Officers Digital Records Archive (RODRA) with an aim to have a better connection with armed forces veteran officers and family pensioners. It will act as an interface between the custodian of officers' records, AG/MP 5&6 and veteran officers, next of kin (NOK).

EBOLA DRUG 'REMDESIVIR' TO PROTECT AGAINST NIPAH VIRUS

An experimental Ebola drug 'remdesivir' is found to cure Nipah virus also according to the new study published in Science Translational Medicine from National Institutes of Health scientists and colleagues. The drug was developed by Gilead Sciences, Inc. in collaboration with scientists from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).

It gives important data points to communities and conservationists to help protect drinking water and the seas. The study was published in the Journal "Geophysical Research Letters".

US EMBASSY LAUNCHES 'EDUCATION USA' APP FOR INDIAN STUDENTS

On the event of Student Visa Day (June 12, 2019), an event that celebrates higher education ties between India and the United States, the American Embassy has launched an app named "Education USA" to help Indian students who wish to study in the US (United States) Universities. The app was launched in collaboration with the United States India Educational Foundation.

ISRO TO LAUNCH ITS OWN SPACE STATION BY 2030: ISRO CHIEF

The Chairman of Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) K Sivan announced that India will have its own Space station by 2030. A space station is like a habitable artificial satellite that is designed to remain in space and is capable of being inhabited by crew members for an extended period of time. The Project is an extension of Gaganyaan mission.

NASA TO SHUT DOWN SPITZER SPACE TELESCOPE AFTER 16 YRS IN 2020

The National Aeronautics and Space Administration's (NASA) Spitzer Space Telescope will be shut down on January 30, 2020, after 16 years of exploring the cosmos in infrared light. This was announced by the Jet Propulsion Laboratory (JPL). It was launched in January 1983 as Infrared Astronomical Satellite to conduct the first infrared survey of the sky. It was jointly developed by t-he United States, the Netherlands, and the United Kingdom.

SRI LANKA LAUNCHED ITS FIRST SATELLITE 'RAVANA-1' INTO ORBIT

Sri Lanka successfully launched its first satellite 'Ravana-1' into orbit from the International Space Station (ISS) along with two other BIRDS 3 satellites from Japan and Nepal. It was deployed to the 400-km of orbit at an inclination of 51.6 degrees using the JAXA (Japanese Aerospace and Exploration Agency) owned Kibo experiment module. The satellite was designed and developed by 2 Sri Lankan engineers - Tharindu Dayaratne and Dulani Chamika.

CRICKET AUSTRALIA SIGNS A MULTI-YEAR PARTNERSHIP WITH HCL

Indian multinational information technology service, HCL Technologies (Hindustan Computers Limited, HCL) has signed a multi-year deal with Cricket Australia (CA), the administrative body of Australian Cricket, which is India's third largest sports deal.

In May 2019, IOC members had voted to support the executive board's recommendation to suspend AIBA's Olympic status.

West Indies batsman Chris Gayle, aged 39, will retire from international cricket after the home Test series against India in August-September 2019. He was the captain of the team in the past and has won 2 T20 World Cup titles with the Windies.

JUSTICE PRASHANT KUMAR APPOINTED AS ACTING CHIEF JUSTICE JHARKHAND HIGH COURT

Justice Prashant Kumar, judge of Jharkhand High Court, is appointed as the Acting Chief Justice of the Jharkhand High Court following the appointment of the present Acting Chief Justice Dhirubhai Naranbhai Patel as the Chief Justice of Delhi High Court. The appointment has been made by Article 223 of the Constitution of India.

Uttarakhand minister Prakash Pant passed away at the age of 58 in the US where he was taking treatment for cancer. He is from Pithoragarh. Pant handed over his portfolios to Chief Minister of Uttarakhand, Trivendra Singh Rawat, before leaving to the United States.

HARYANA GOVT WITHDRAWS EPBG QUOTA FOR ACCOMMODATING EWS RESERVATIONS

Haryana government has issued an order to withdraw Economically Backward Persons in General Caste Category (EBPG) reservation since Economically Weaker Sections reservation (EWS) came into effect. EWS comes under Constitution 124th Amendment Bill, 2019 passed by the parliament to allow 10% reservation for economically backward sections in the general category in government jobs and academic institutions in January 2019

GOA CABINET APPROVES 10% QUOTA FOR ECONOMICALLY BACKWARD SECTIONS

The Goa cabinet chaired by the Chief minister Pramod Sawant approved the amendment of 10 percent reservation for economically weaker sections of a general category in education and employment. The state cabinet also assured the reservation for Muslims and Christians, who are not covered under the quota.

FIRST MEETING OF ANDHRA PRADESH CABINET APPROVES SEVERAL KEY DECISIONS

The new cabinet meeting chaired by the Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister YS Jaganmohan Reddy has approved some key decisions including hike of old age pension from 2,000 to Rs 2,250 and approves salaries of Aasha workers (health workers in rural areas) from Rs.3,000 to Rs.10,000 per month and also increased the salary of community health workers under the Tribal Welfare Department from current Rs 400 to Rs 4,000 a month.

KARNATAKA GOVERNMENT LAUNCHES "PINK SARATHI VEHICLES"

The state government of Karnataka launched "Pink Sarathi vehicles" for women safety. This was launched by the Chief Minister of Karnataka, H.D.Kumaraswamy. The vehicles were procured by the Bangalore Metropolitan Transport Corporation (BMTC) under the 'Nirbhaya' scheme. BMTC has received Rs.56.07 crore from the central Government.

ASSAM TRANSPORT MINISTER CHANDRA MOHAN PATOWARY LAUNCHED STATE TRANSPORT CORPORATION'S CHALO APP

Assam Transport Minister Chandra Mohan Patowary launched the Assam State Transport Corporation's (ASTC) Chalo app for Guwahati. It will help the travellers to know about the live arrival time of their bus. The Chalo app is developed by the Zophop Technologies Pvt Ltd, a technology-driven transport solutions company. Assam became the first state in India to have a state-wide smart transport solution and common mobility card for its commuters.

BIHAR CABINET APPROVED THE PROPOSAL TO PUNISH CHILDREN WHO ABANDON THEIR ELDERLY PARENTS; ALSO SANCTIONED DPR FOR DAGMARA HYDEL POWER PROJECT

Bihar Cabinet led by the Chief Minister Nitish Kumar approved the proposal seeking provisions to punish children who abandon their elderly parents. They could face jail time over charges of abandonment. The state cabinet also sanctioned Rs 11.68 crore for preparation of a Detailed Project Report (DPR) for construction of a multi-purpose 130-MW Dagmara hydel power project in Supaul district.

IN BIHAR, 160 CHILDREN LOST THEIR LIVES DUE TO ENCEPHALITIS AND HEAT-WAVE

In Bihar, 160 children have lost their lives due to Acute Encephalitis Syndrome (AES) and heat wave. The total toll due to AES and heat wave has been pegged at 104 and 56 respectively. The toxic substance in lychee causes Acute Encephalitis Syndrome (AES), locally known as Chamki Bukhar, which is a form of brain fever that happens due to the inflammation of the brain.

UTTAR PRADESH STATE CABINET GIVES APPROVAL TO 6 PROPOSALS

The Uttar Pradesh state cabinet chaired by the Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath approved six Proposals including the one to convene the state Assembly's Monsoon Session from July 18, 2019. Among others, The cabinet has also gave its assent to a proposal regarding the formation of Gorakhpur Zoological Park with the cost of Rs 181.82 crore. It would be called as Ashfaqullah Zoological Park.

HP GOVERNMENT MAKES GPS TRACKING DEVICES MANDATORY FOR TREKKERS
