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

Answer With Explanation

1. Answer: C

In part (c), the word 'assumed' has been mentioned which means there is one assumption in the sentence and for that there has to be one proposition. If you see carefully, the last part of (d) i.e. 'sleeping' is a verb and the first part of (c) i.e. 'unihemispherically' is an adverb and we know an adverb qualifies a verb, and hence c has to follow d. Therefore, we got one pair i.e. dc. Now, d and 'these findings' in part (b) is the proposition from which the assumption in (a) is derived because 'autopilot' in part (a) indicates 'the dolphins can swim while sleeping' in (d). Therefore d follows b and a follows c. Therefore, option (C) is the correct answer choice to this question.

2. Answer: E

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
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
