Besides means "in addition to", and means the same as apart from. Since "from" is already present. Position A should have "apart". Hence, the correct answer is B.

5) Answer: C

Position C requires a noun that can be described as "attractive". There is only one noun among the highlighted words (approach). For position D, we need a verb that is suitable to be an "ability of crops". "Resist" is best suited here. This means the sequence must end with DA. There is only one sequence among the given options that does so, i.e. CDAB.

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The sentence is comparing two methods of breeding techniques. So, it should be “compared” at position A. Hence, the correct answer is C.

6) Answer: C

At B we need an adjective to describe the type of political leaders. Of the highlighted words, only ‘senior’ is an adjective which implies that C is in the second position upon rearrangement.

‘Adopt’ means to formally approve or accept (a report or suggestion). ‘Invocation’ means the action of invoking someone or something. Thus, in the context of the sentence, ‘invocation’ or D should be in the first position. While ‘adopt’ or A should be in the fourth position. So this allows ‘understating’ or B to be in the third position. Thus the correct order of words is B-C & D-A. As per this, ‘understating’ should be replaced by ‘underscore’. Now, represent (something) as being smaller or less important than it really is. ‘Underscored’ means to emphasize. Thus, ‘understating’ is incorrect contextually and grammatically. It is in the present tense, while the past tense should be used.

Thus, option C is the correct answer.

7) Answer: E

The sentence is grammatically and contextually correct. The given words are also contextually correct. So, no interchange and word replacement is required.

8) Answer: A

The words are not correctly placed. The correct place replacement for the sentence here B-A & D-C.

Disregard means an act or state of deliberately not paying attention or caring about something. But the sentence describes the internet as “awash with cranks”, which means the speakers clearly have gone through the materials on the internet and described them as such.

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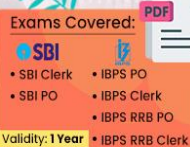
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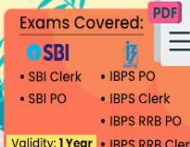
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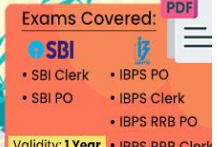
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
